Weekly setup

Near-term considerations: volume confirmation is below normal.

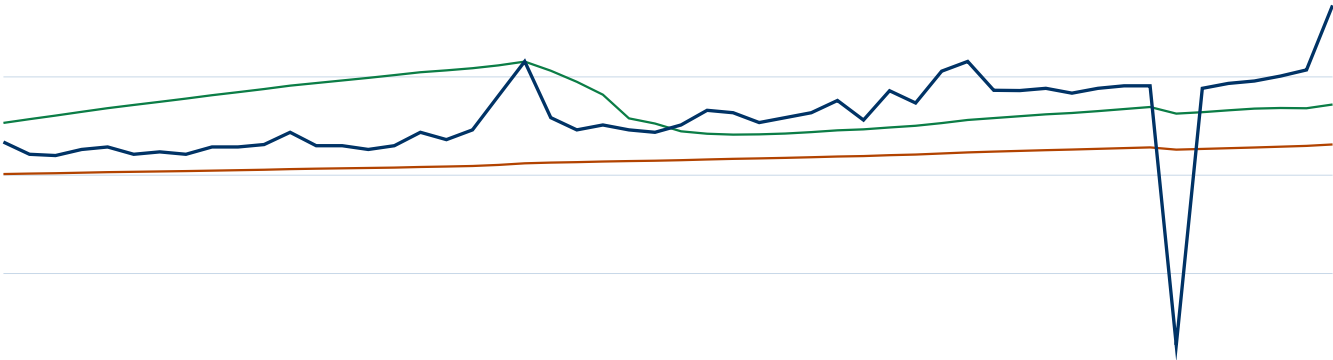

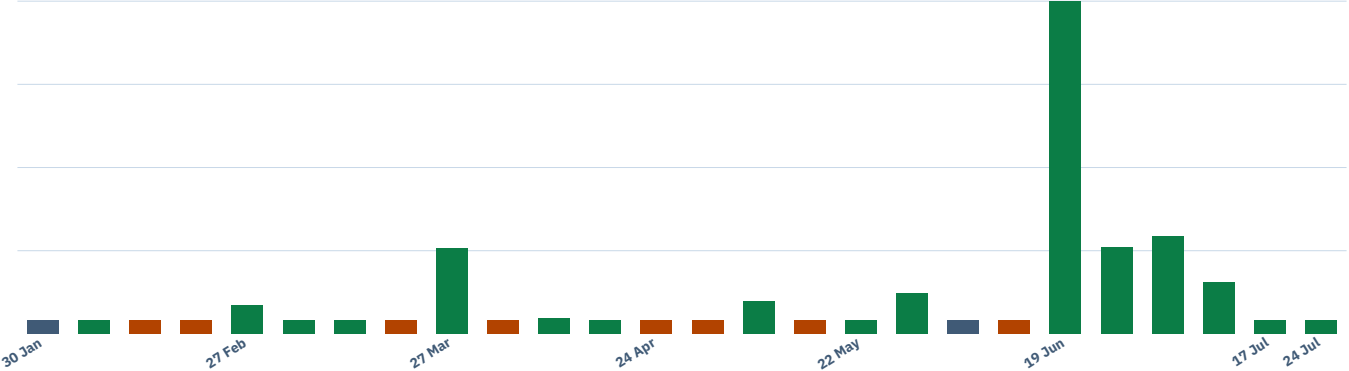

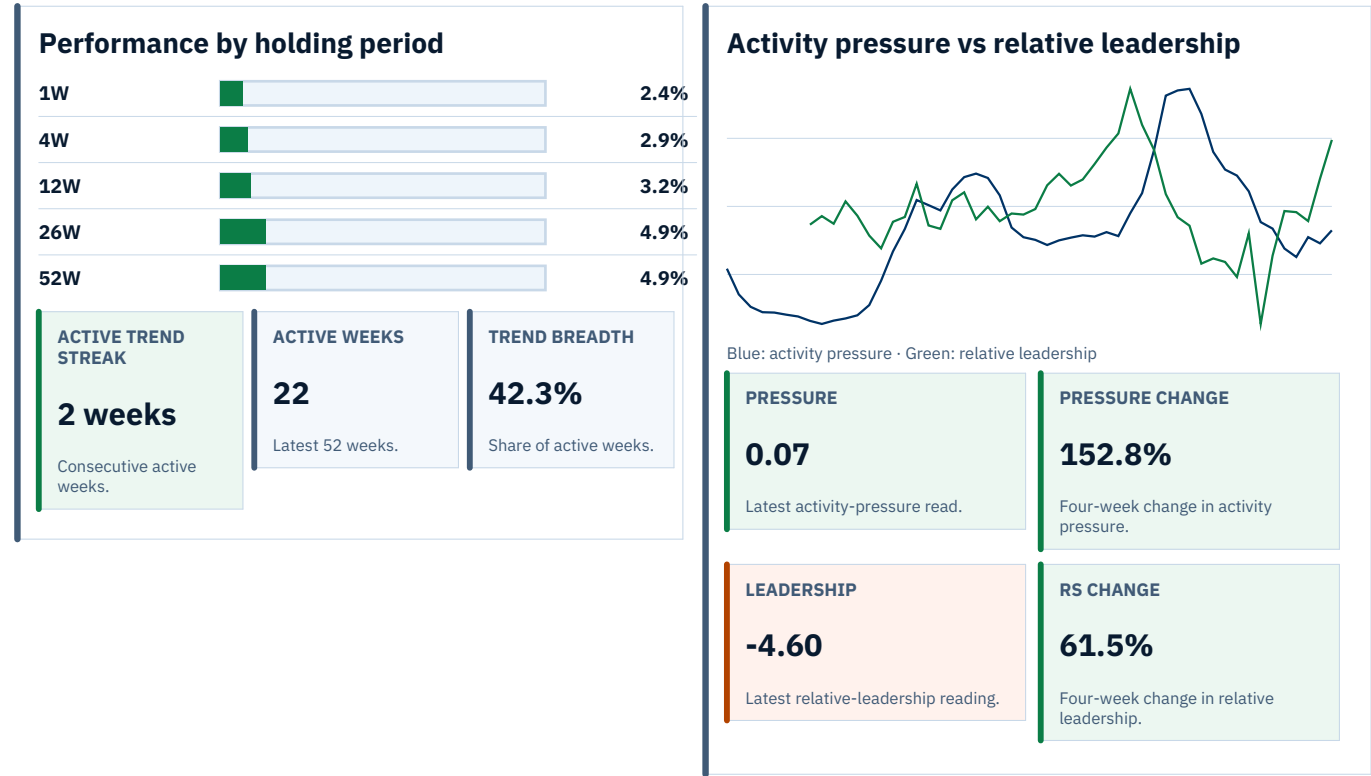

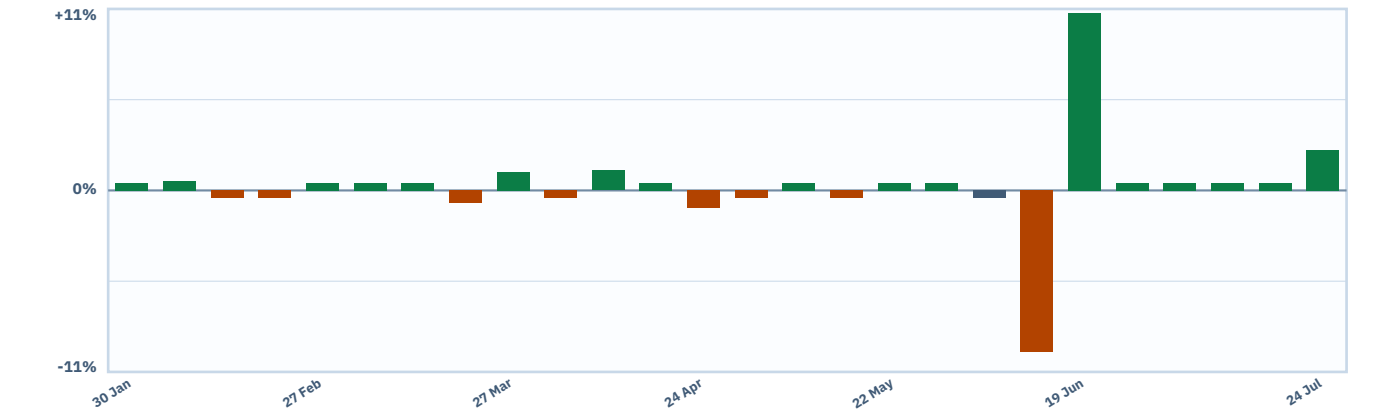
