The weekly trend is not active. Price is -0.3% below the Trend Line and sits at 31.3% of its 52-week range. The latest completed week returned 1.5%, after a 6.3% four-week move. The latest factor snapshot indicates quality ranks strongly versus its universe; growth ranks strongly; valuation is neither clearly cheap nor expensive. Options positioning is bullish with 39/100 conviction, while the latest news-sentiment score is 60/100. Near-term considerations: earnings are due in 84d.

What is working

- Activity pressure is positive on the latest completed week.
- Next-week expectancy is positive at 55.71% based on similar historical setup states.

What could go wrong

- The trend backdrop is inactive, so price action has not confirmed a constructive regime.
- Price is below the Trend Line, which keeps downside pressure in focus.
- Price is below Fair Value, so the market is still discounting the latest tape.
- Activity pressure is weak, so confirmation is not yet broad enough.

What to watch next

- Trend Line remains the key weekly regime level.
- Activity pressure is the gauge to monitor for confirmation or fade.
- A volume ratio above 1.5x would show stronger participation in the next move.

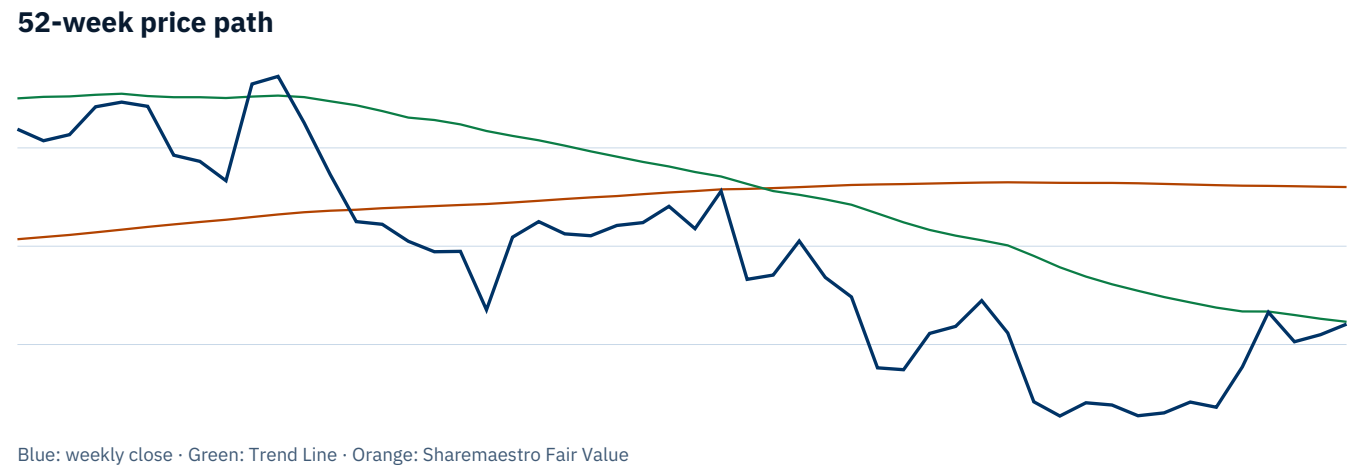

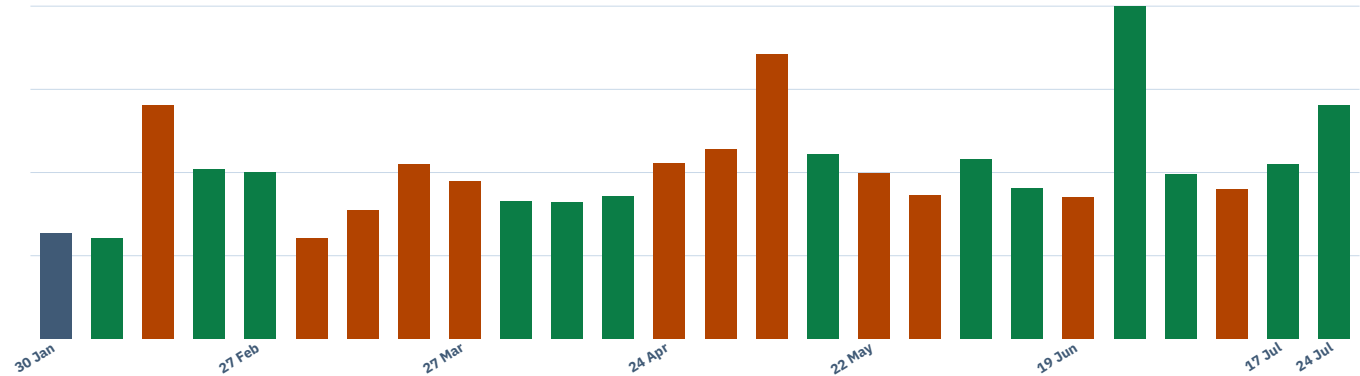
02 · VOLUME AND DEMAND

Activity pressure and institutional-style signals

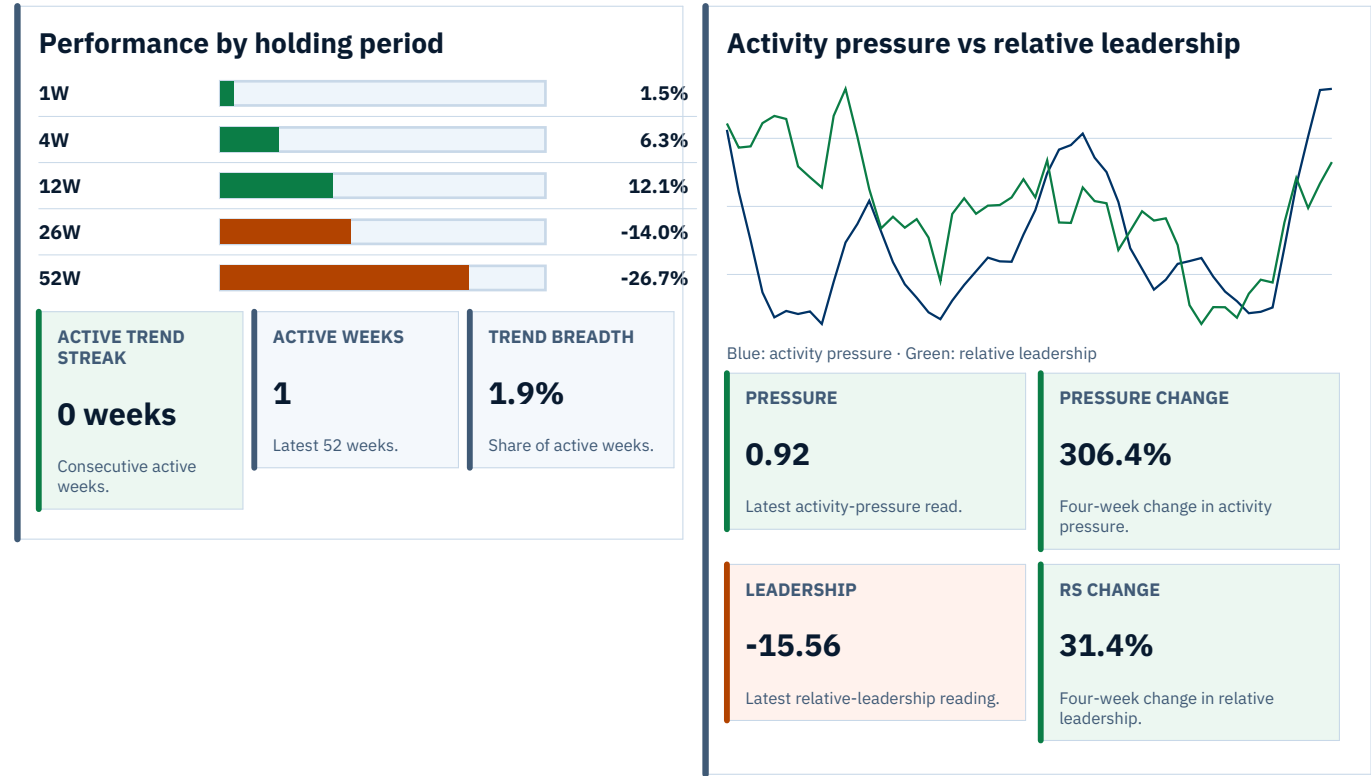

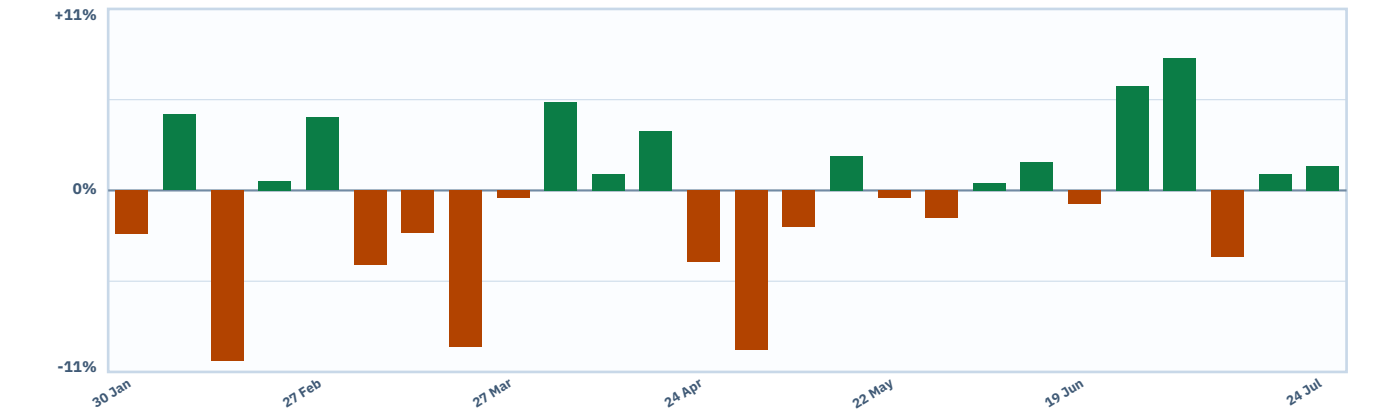
