Weekly setup

Constructive, but selective

The weekly trend is active. Price is 4.4% above the Trend Line and sits at 40.4% of its 52-week range. The latest completed week returned -13.6%, after a 6.3% four-week move. The latest factor snapshot indicates quality is middle-of-the-pack; growth ranks strongly; valuation is expensive relative to peers. Options positioning is volatility with 53/100 conviction, while the latest news-sentiment score is 51/100. Near-term considerations: earnings are due in 35d.

Technical setup score 36/100. This score describes the weekly technical setup; the conclusion above also considers fundamentals, positioning, sentiment, and event risk.

What is working

- The trend backdrop is active with a 3-week active streak.
- Price is above the Trend Line, keeping the weekly tape constructive.
- Activity pressure is positive on the latest completed week.

What could go wrong

- Price is below Fair Value, so the market is still discounting the latest tape.
- Next-week expectancy is negative at 42.34% based on similar historical setup states.
- Activity pressure is weak, so confirmation is not yet broad enough.
- The share remains more than 20% below its 52-week high.

What to watch next

- Trend Line remains the key weekly regime level.
- Activity pressure is the gauge to monitor for confirmation or fade.
- A volume ratio above 1.5x would show stronger participation in the next move.

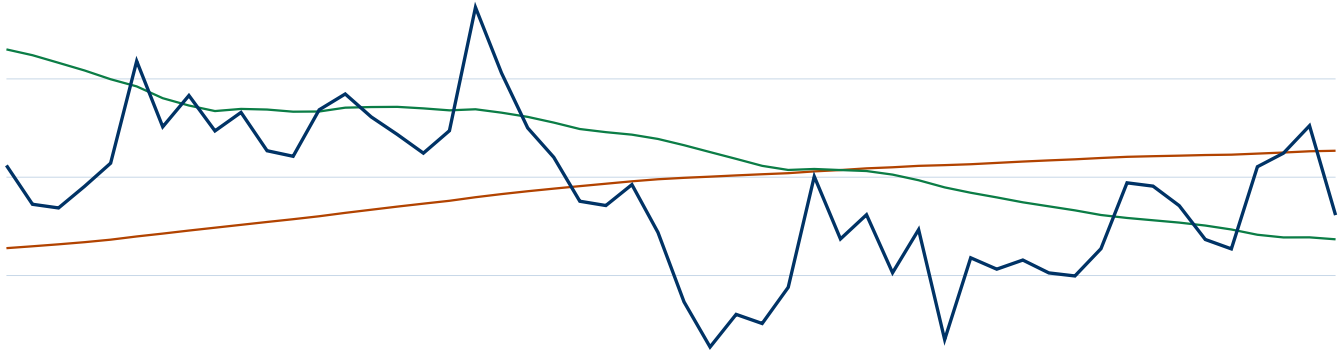

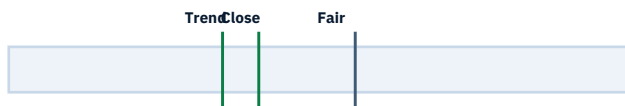

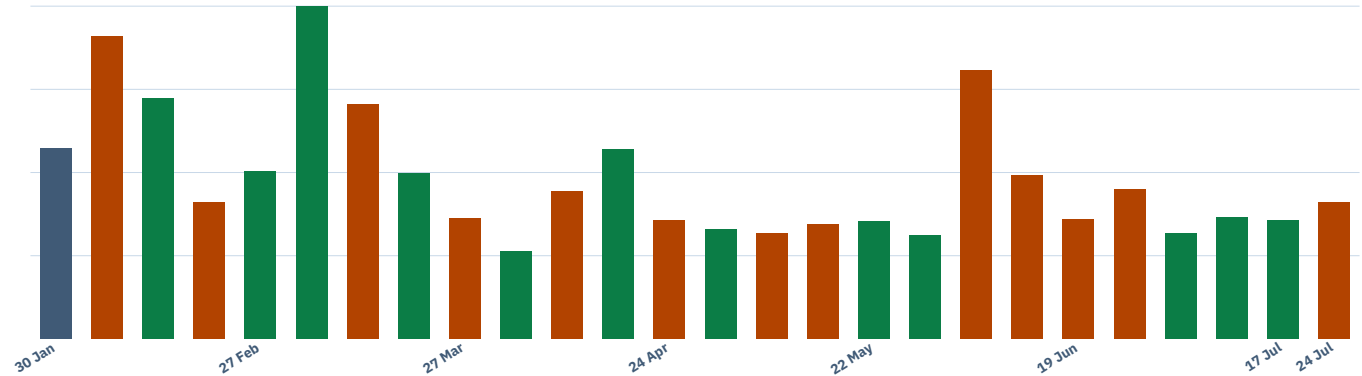

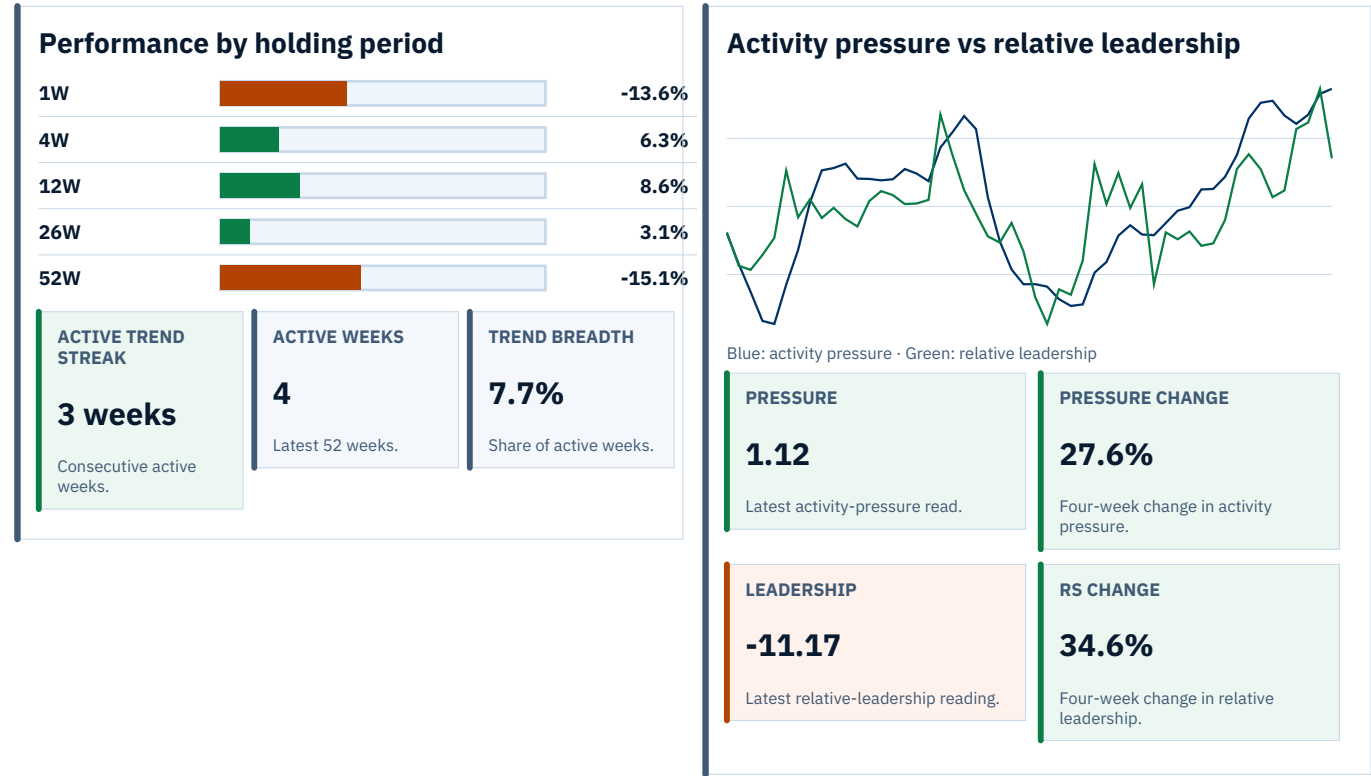

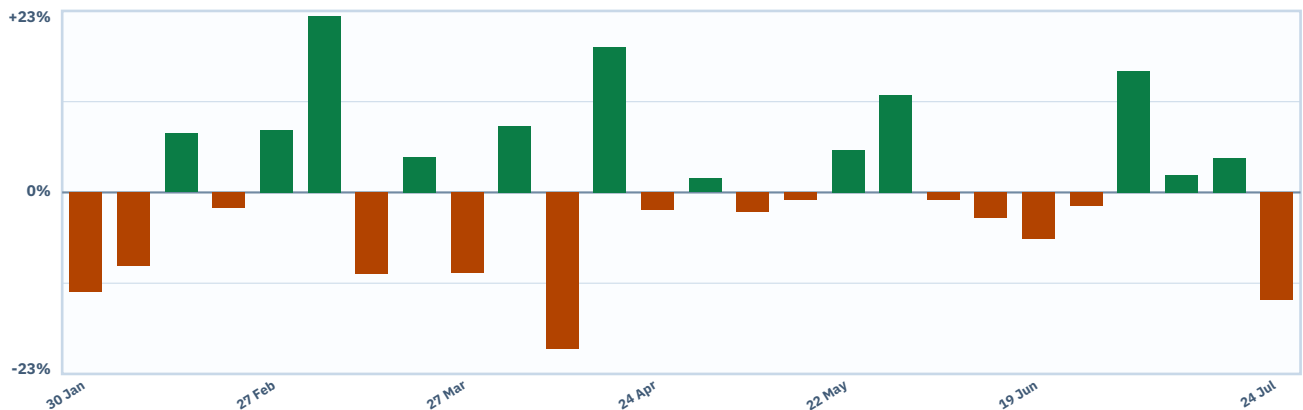
