The weekly trend is not active. Price is -15.7% below the Trend Line and sits at 50.0% of its 52-week range. The latest completed week returned -8.3%, after a -5.2% four-week move. The latest factor snapshot indicates quality is middle-of-the-pack; growth is moderate; valuation is neither clearly cheap nor expensive. The latest news-sentiment score is 51/100.

What is working

- Price is above Fair Value, showing premium demand versus the model.

What could go wrong

- The trend backdrop is inactive, so price action has not confirmed a constructive regime.
- Price is below the Trend Line, which keeps downside pressure in focus.
- Activity pressure is negative, which weakens the current setup.
- Next-week expectancy is negative at 36.35% based on similar historical setup states.

What to watch next

- Trend Line remains the key weekly regime level.
- Activity pressure is the gauge to monitor for confirmation or fade.
- A volume ratio above 1.5x would show stronger participation in the next move.

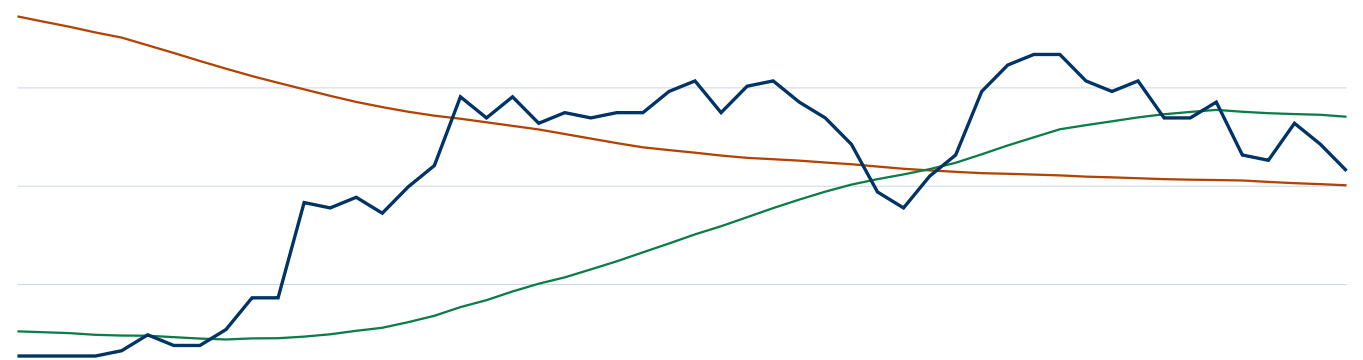

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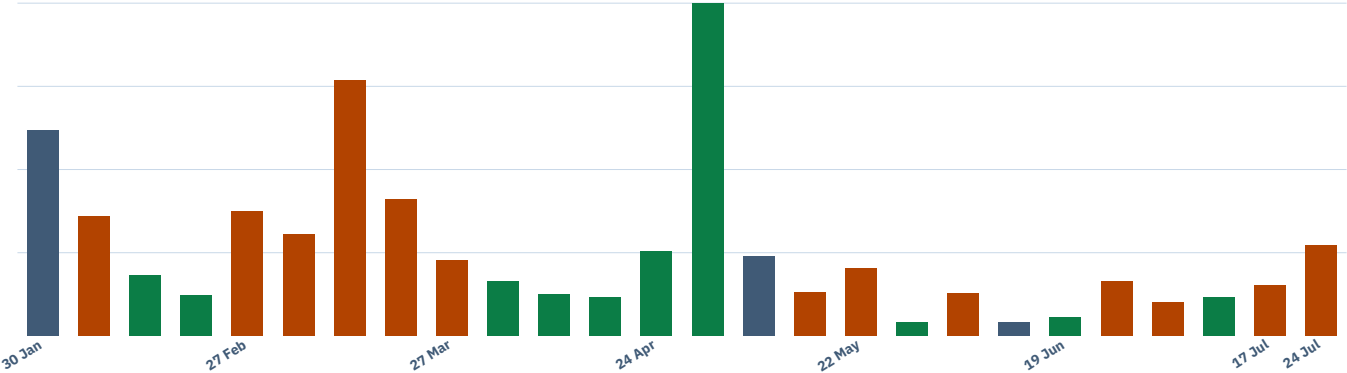
02 · VOLUME AND DEMAND

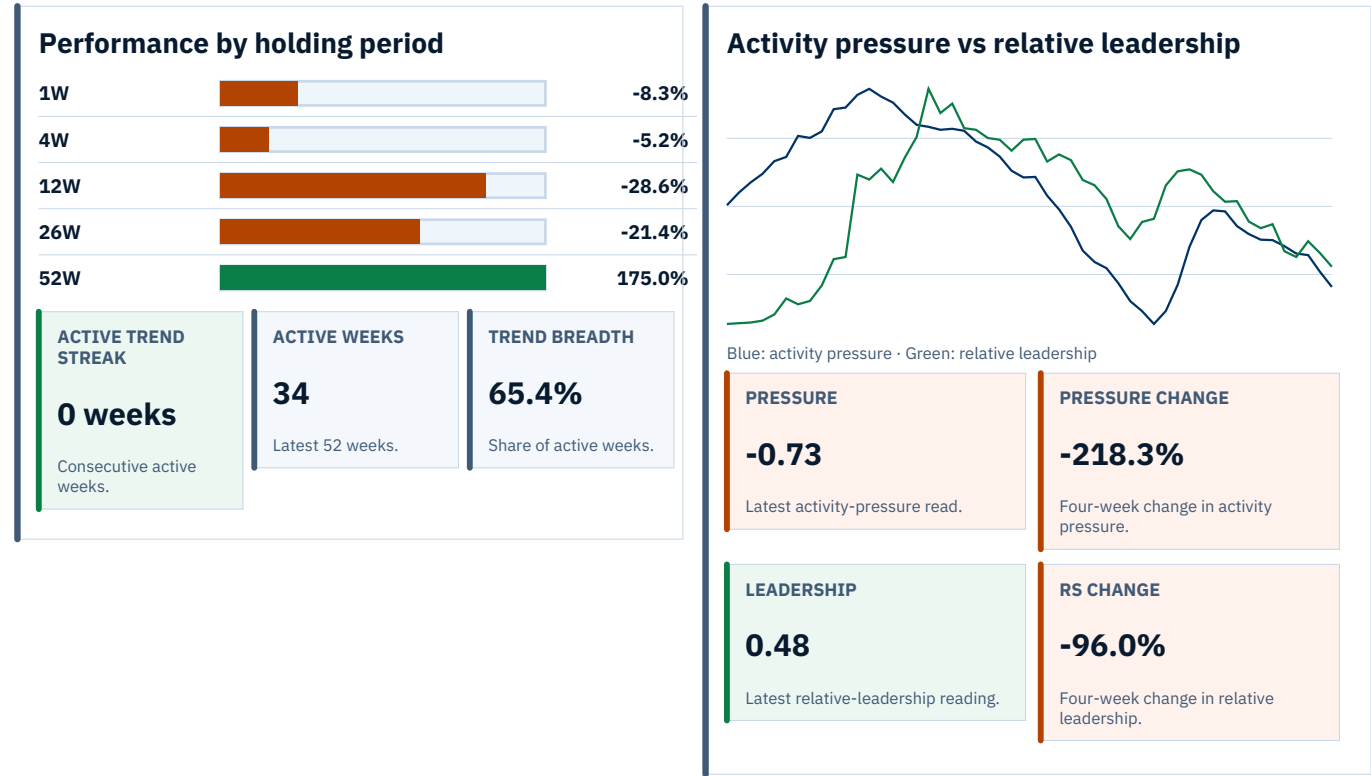

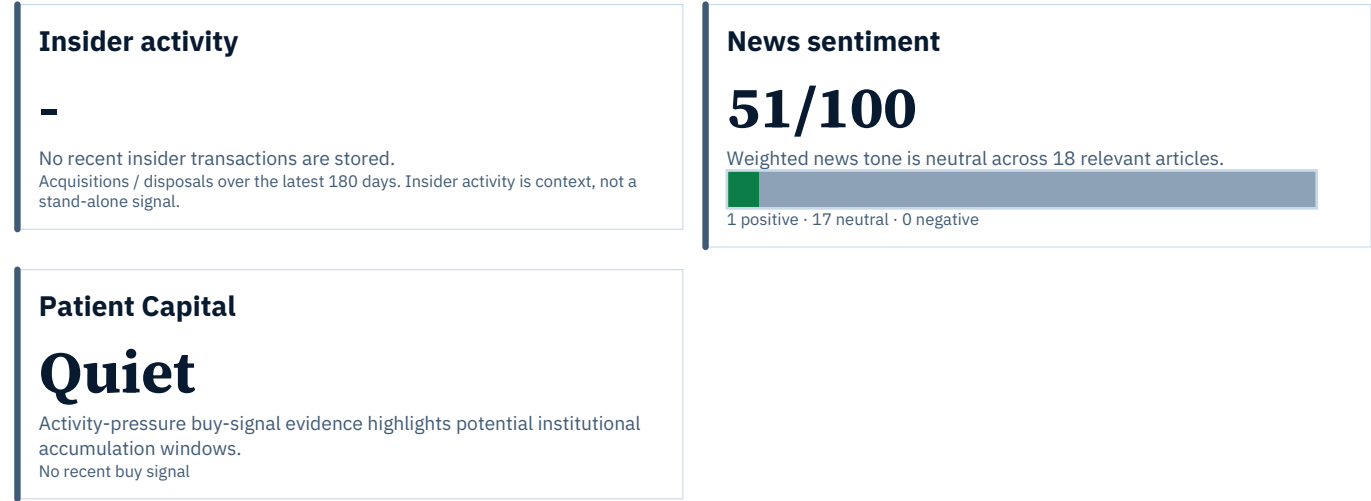

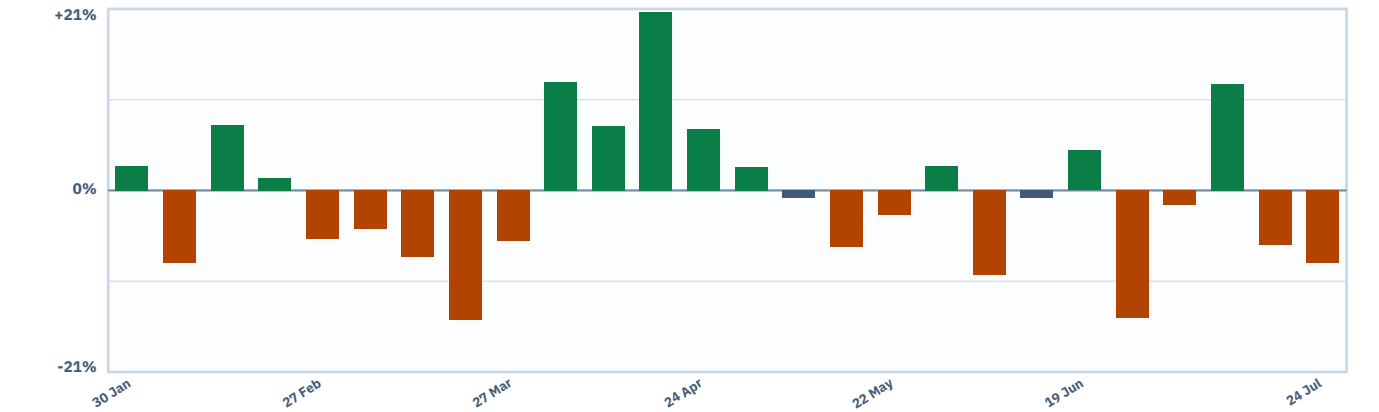
