The main constraint is factors: O'Shaughnessy factor stack blends value, quality, momentum, and confidence. The combined read is constructive, but confirmation should still come from follow-through in price, volume, and group structure.

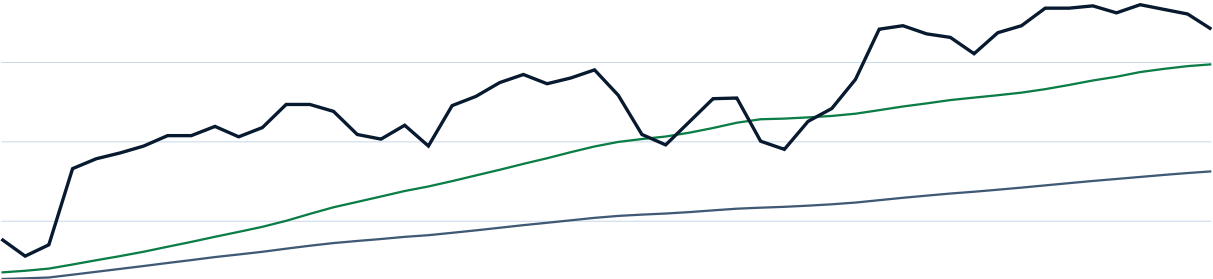

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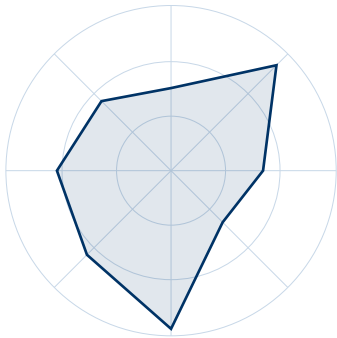

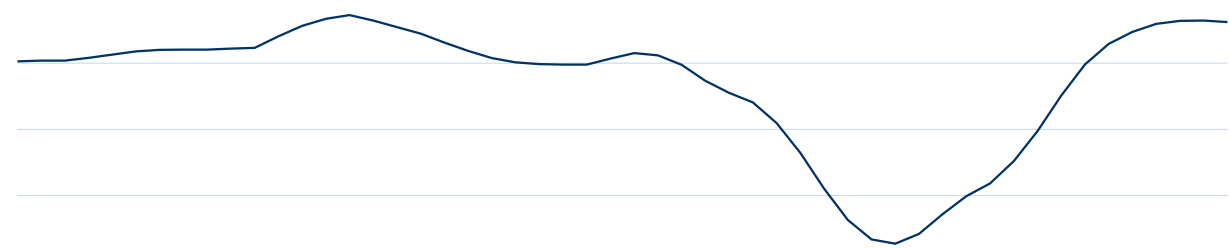

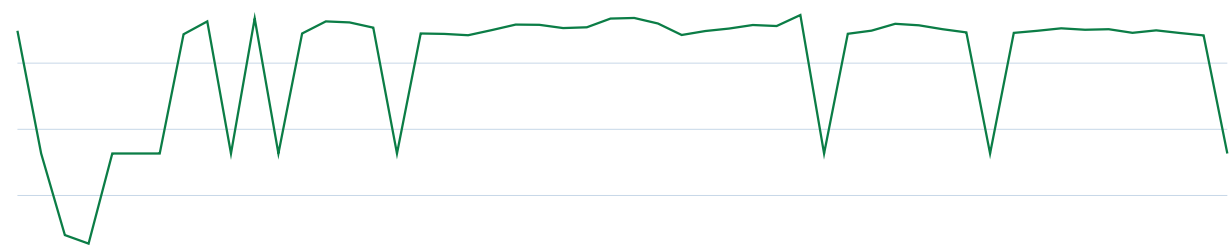

Watch next

- Trend Line remains the key weekly regime level.
- Activity pressure is the gauge to monitor for confirmation or fade.
- A volume ratio above 1.5x would show stronger participation in the next move.
