Weekly setup

Constructive, but selective

The weekly trend is active. Price is 12.8% above the Trend Line and sits at 91.7% of its 52-week range. The latest completed week returned -1.9%, after a 9.7% four-week move. The latest factor snapshot indicates quality ranks weakly versus its universe; growth is moderate; valuation is neither clearly cheap nor expensive. Options positioning is bearish with 40/100 conviction, while the latest news-sentiment score is 52/100. Near-term considerations: price is close to its 52-week high; earnings are due in 4d.

Technical setup score 65/100. This score describes the weekly technical setup; the conclusion above also considers fundamentals, positioning, sentiment, and event risk.

What is working

- The trend backdrop is active with a 43-week active streak.
- Price is above the Trend Line, keeping the weekly tape constructive.
- Price is above Fair Value, showing premium demand versus the model.
- Activity pressure is constructive, supporting the smart-money activity read.

What could go wrong

- Activity pressure is negative, which weakens the current setup.
- 13 reversal markers appear in the recent smart-money tape.

What to watch next

- Trend Line remains the key weekly regime level.
- Activity pressure is the gauge to monitor for confirmation or fade.
- A volume ratio above 1.5x would show stronger participation in the next move.

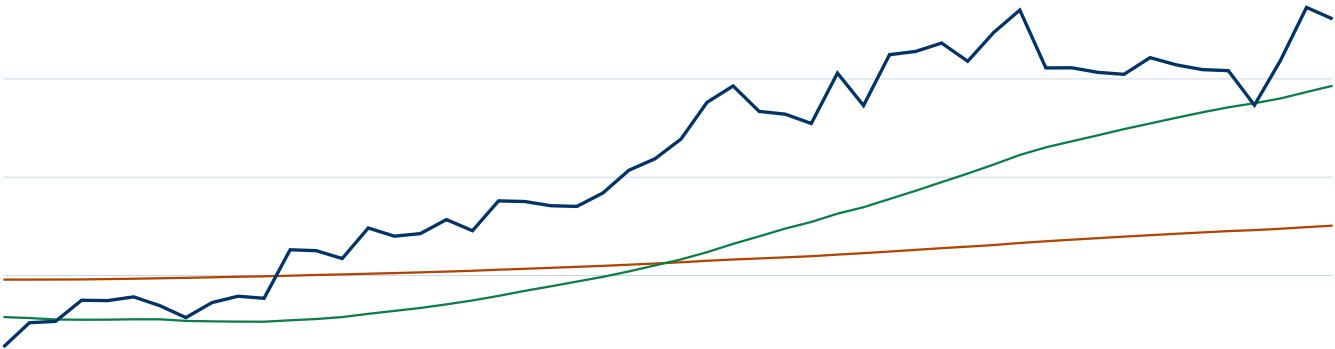

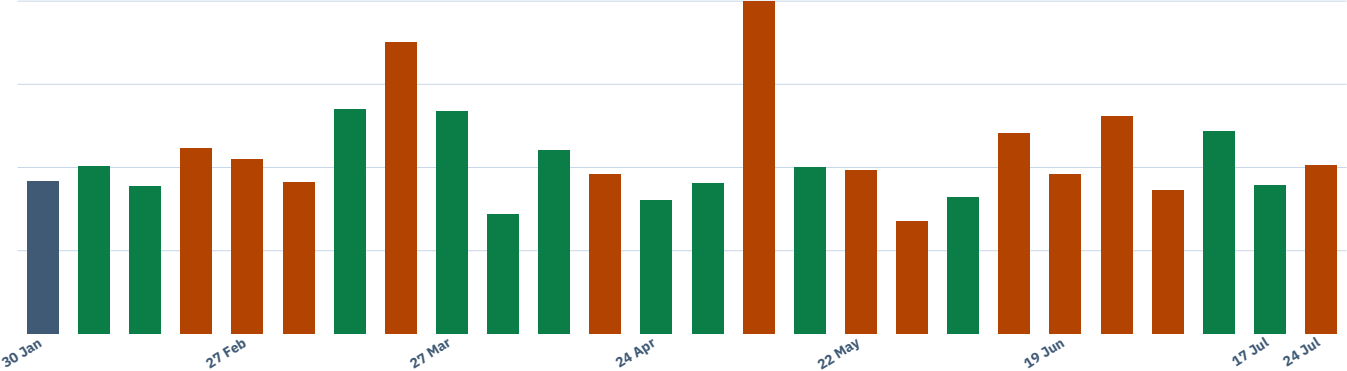
02 · VOLUME AND DEMAND

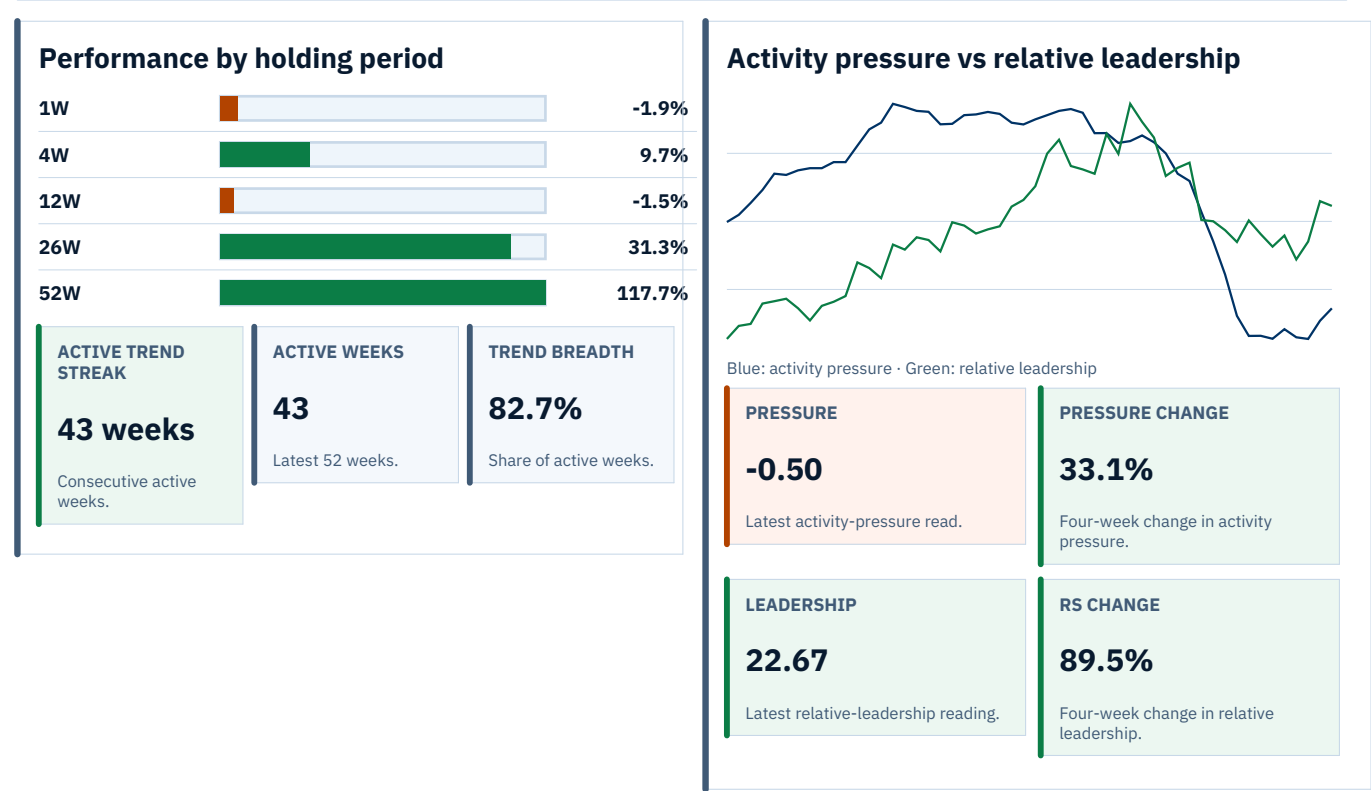

How to read this

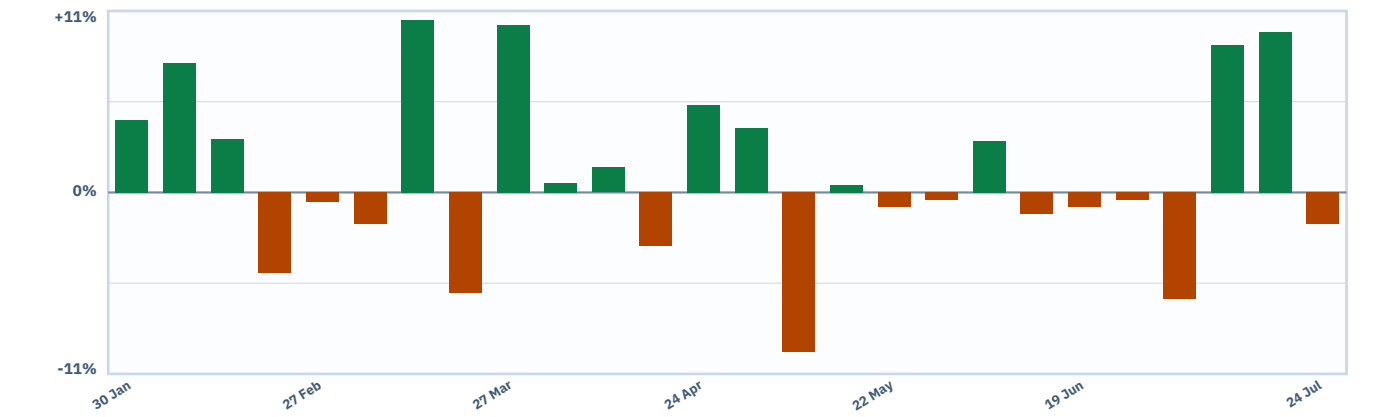
