The strongest supporting evidence is factors: O'Shaughnessy factor stack blends value, quality, momentum, and confidence. The main constraint is indicator analysis: Latest 12-week confirmation: trend 0/12, activity pressure 1/12, relative leadership 6/12. The combined read is defensive, so risk control and evidence of stabilization matter more than headline upside.

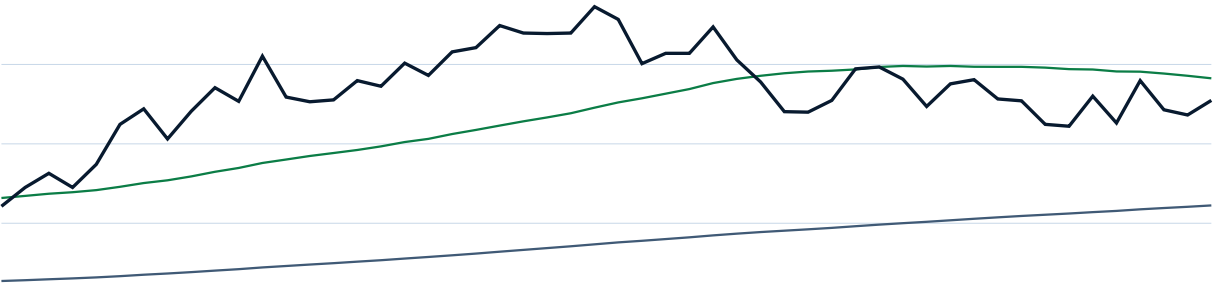

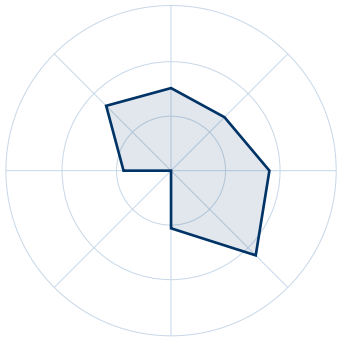

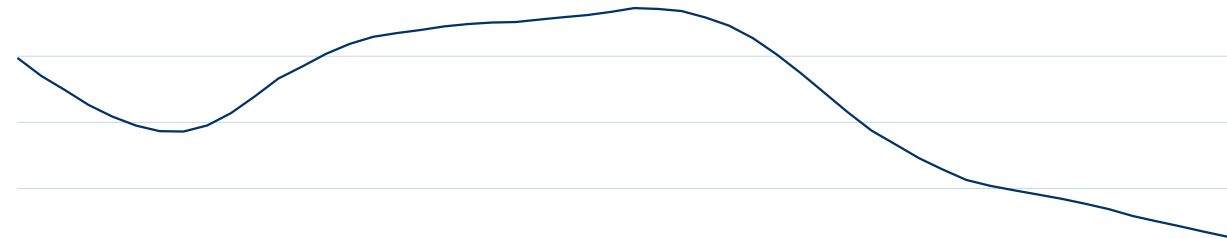

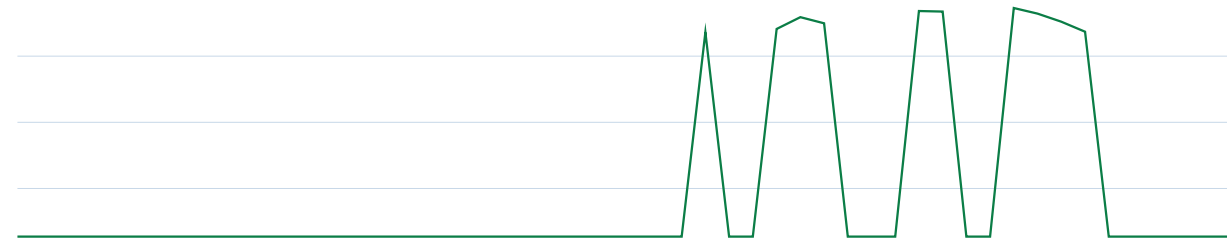

### Opportunity signals

- Price is above Fair Value, showing premium demand versus the model.
- Activity pressure is positive on the latest completed week.

### Risk signals

- The trend backdrop is inactive, so price action has not confirmed a constructive regime.
- Price is below the Trend Line, which keeps downside pressure in focus.
- Activity pressure is weak, so confirmation is not yet broad enough.
- The share remains more than 20% below its 52-week high.

### Watch next

- Trend Line remains the key weekly regime level.
- Activity pressure is the gauge to monitor for confirmation or fade.
- A volume ratio above 1.5x would show stronger participation in the next move.
