The strongest supporting evidence is patient capital: Activity-pressure buy-signal evidence highlights potential institutional accumulation windows. The main constraint is weekly tape: Trend, activity pressure, participation, and risk combine to a 36/100 tape read. The combined read is balanced, making the next change in trend, sentiment, or options pressure especially important.

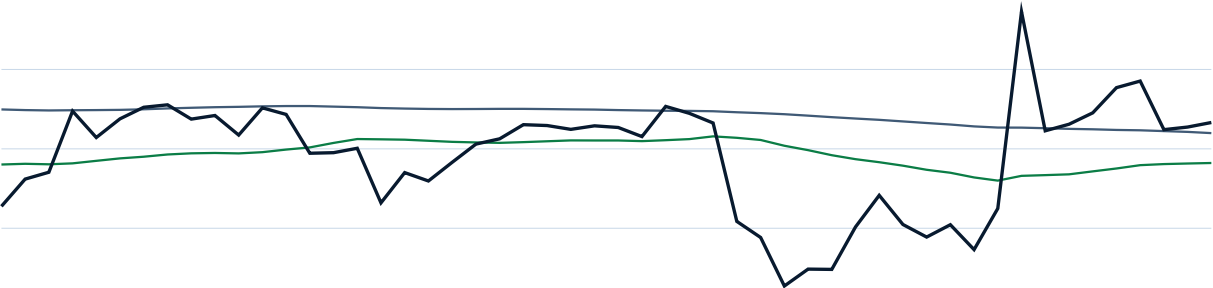

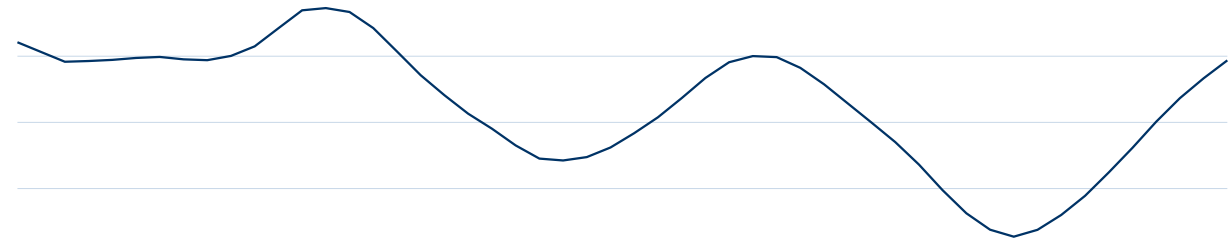

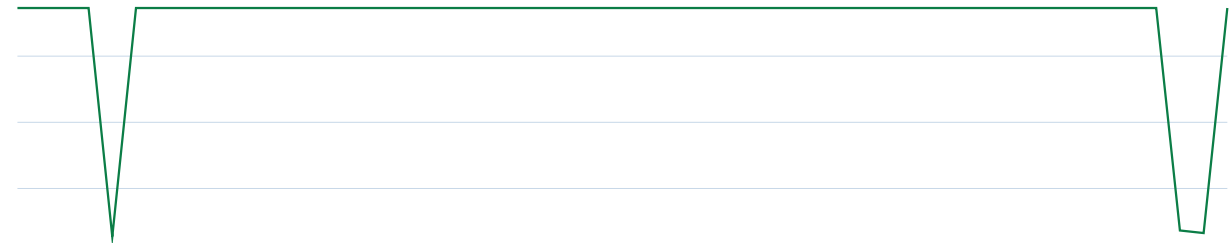
