The weekly trend is active. Price is 10.6% above the Trend Line and sits at 92.3% of its 52-week range. The latest completed week returned 3.9%, after a 5.1% four-week move. The latest news-sentiment score is 51/100. Near-term considerations: price is close to its 52-week high; volume confirmation is below normal.

What is working

- The trend backdrop is active with a 2-week active streak.
- Price is above the Trend Line, keeping the weekly tape constructive.
- Price is above Fair Value, showing premium demand versus the model.
- Activity pressure is positive on the latest completed week.

What could go wrong

- Activity pressure is weak, so confirmation is not yet broad enough.
- 3 reversal markers appear in the recent smart-money tape.

What to watch next

- Price is close to its 52-week high; watch for continuation or exhaustion.
- Trend Line remains the key weekly regime level.
- Activity pressure is the gauge to monitor for confirmation or fade.
- A volume ratio above 1.5x would show stronger participation in the next move.

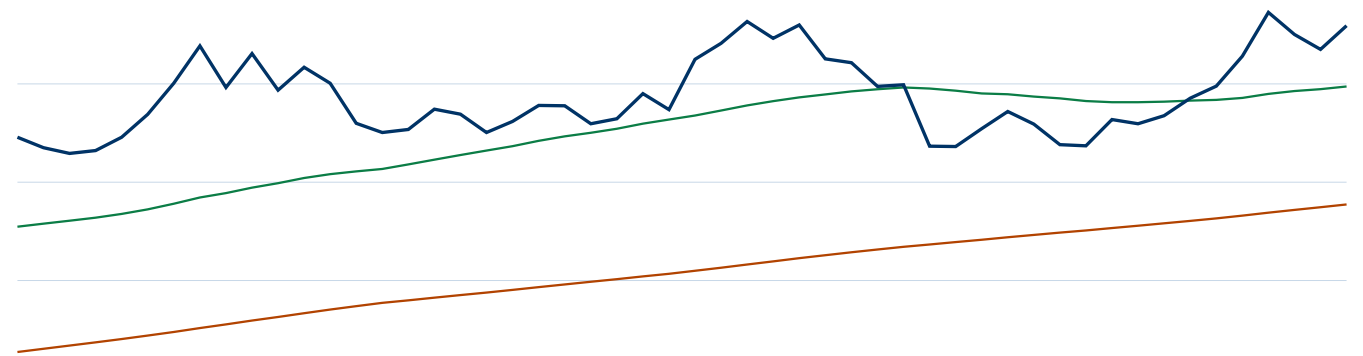

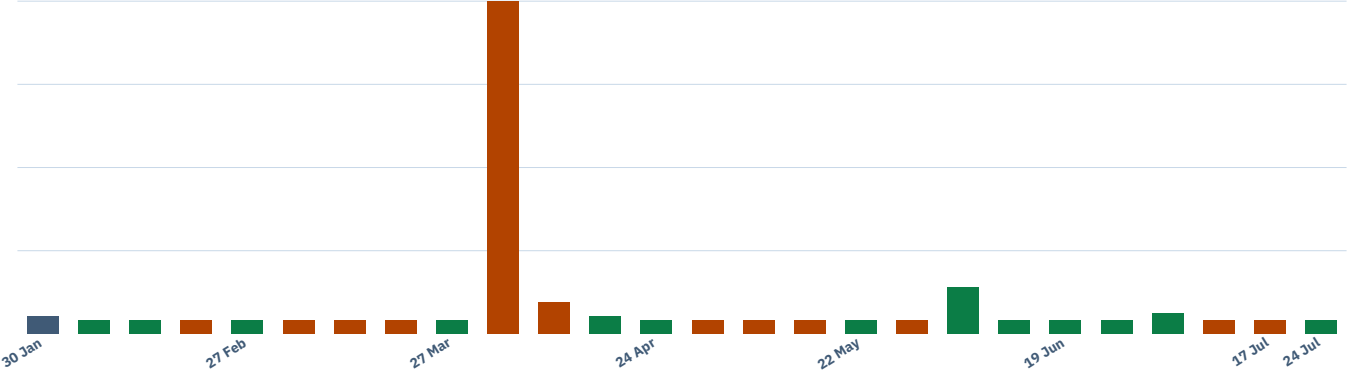
02 · VOLUME AND DEMAND

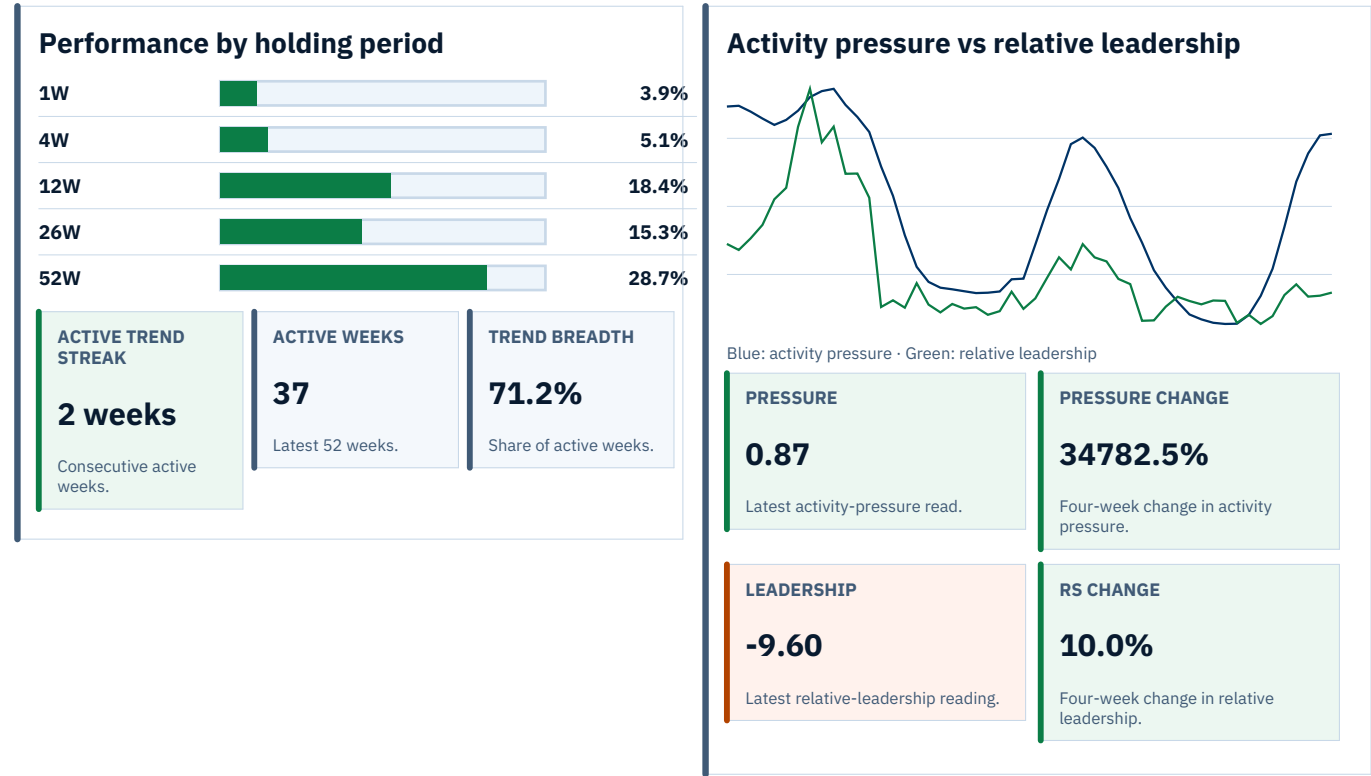

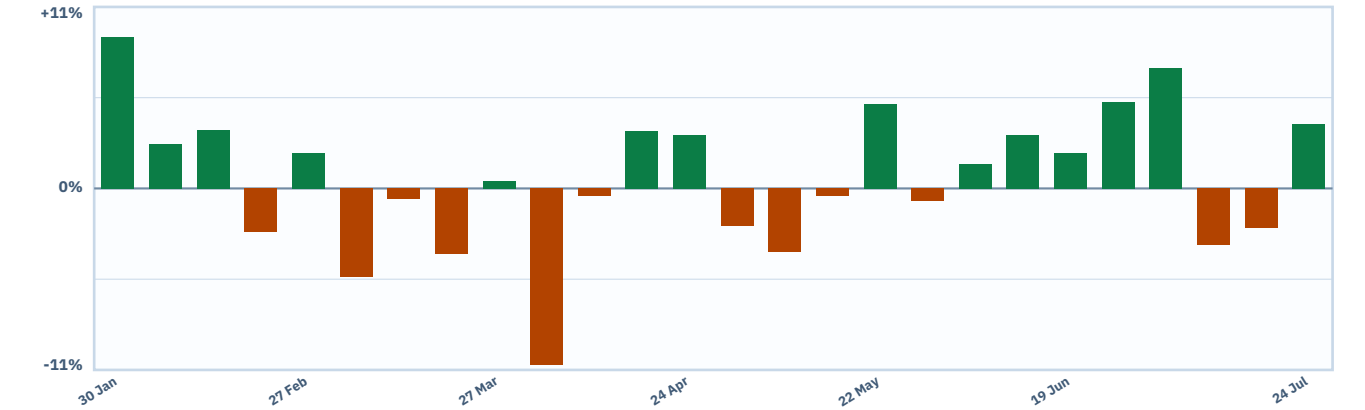
