Weekly setup

Constructive, but selective

The weekly trend is active. Price is 14.6% above the Trend Line and sits at 94.5% of its 52-week range. The latest completed week returned 1.0%, after a 2.6% four-week move. The latest factor snapshot indicates quality is middle-of-the-pack; growth is moderate; valuation is inexpensive relative to peers. Options positioning is mixed with 33/100 conviction, while the latest news-sentiment score is 59/100. Near-term considerations: price is close to its 52-week high; volume confirmation is below normal; earnings are due in 82d.

Technical setup score 69/100. This score describes the weekly technical setup; the conclusion above also considers fundamentals, positioning, sentiment, and event risk.

What is working

- The trend backdrop is active with a 54-week active streak.
- Price is above the Trend Line, keeping the weekly tape constructive.
- Price is above Fair Value, showing premium demand versus the model.
- Activity pressure is positive on the latest completed week.

What could go wrong

- 3 reversal markers appear in the recent smart-money tape.

What to watch next

- Price is close to its 52-week high; watch for continuation or exhaustion.
- Trend Line remains the key weekly regime level.
- Activity pressure is the gauge to monitor for confirmation or fade.
- A volume ratio above 1.5x would show stronger participation in the next move.

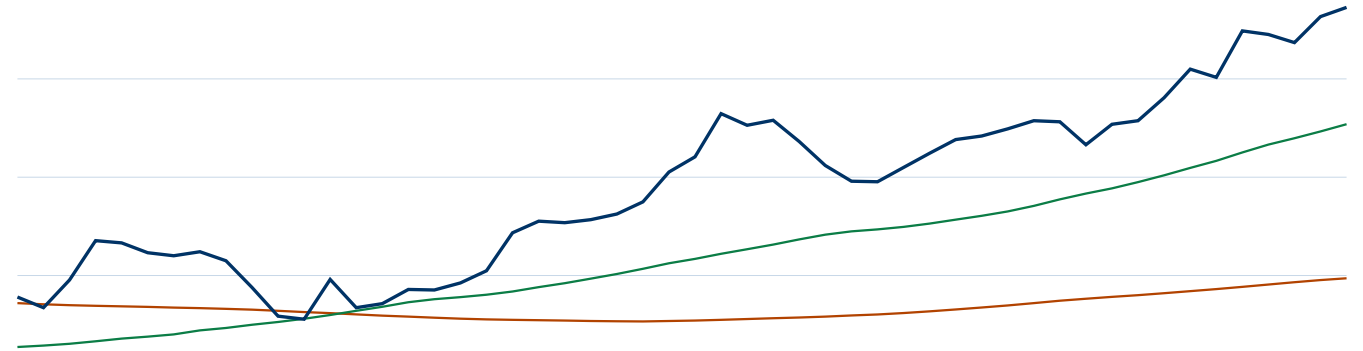

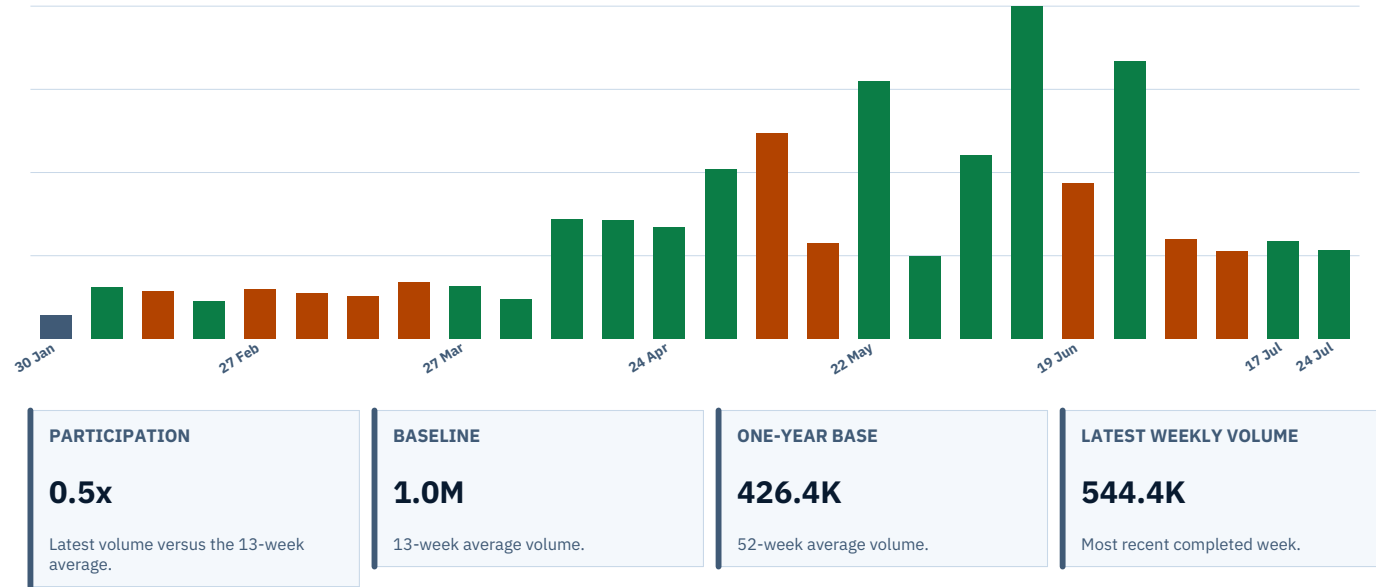
02 · VOLUME AND DEMAND

Is real participation confirming the move?

Latest weekly volume is 0.5x the 13-week average. Participation is below its recent norm, so price strength is not receiving full volume confirmation.

These indicators assess whether participation is improving beneath price. They are supporting evidence, not proof of institutional buying.

Is performance persistent—and is the stock leading?

Performance is 2.6% over four weeks, 14.1% over 12 weeks, and 38.0% over one year. The current trend has remained active for 54 consecutive weeks.

How to read this

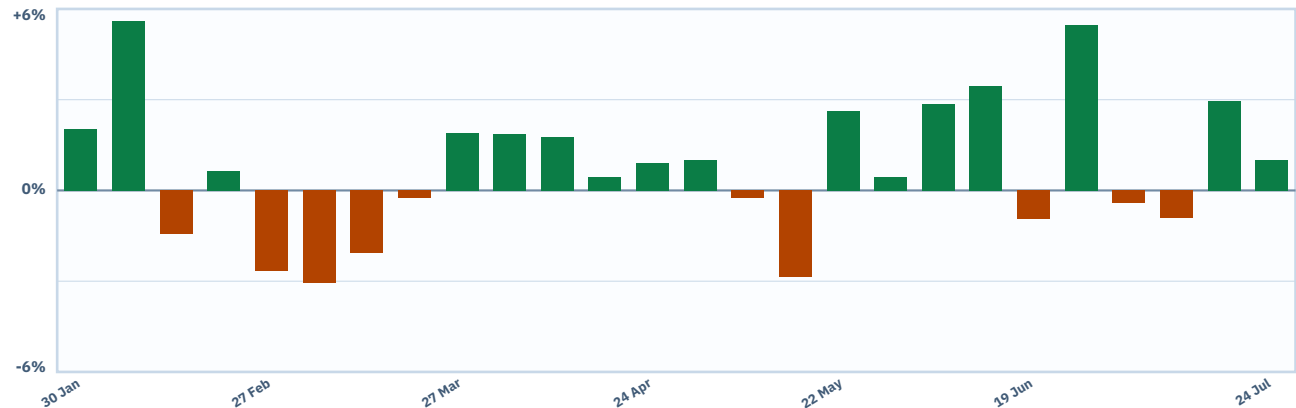
