The weekly trend is active. Price is 12.1% above the Trend Line and sits at 72.7% of its 52-week range. The latest completed week returned -2.9%, after a -3.5% four-week move. The latest factor snapshot indicates quality ranks strongly versus its universe; growth is moderate; valuation is neither clearly cheap nor expensive. Options positioning is mixed with 38/100 conviction, while the latest news-sentiment score is 47/100. Near-term considerations: volume confirmation is below normal; earnings are due in 7d.

Technical setup score 51/100. This score describes the weekly technical setup; the conclusion above also considers fundamentals, positioning, sentiment, and event risk.

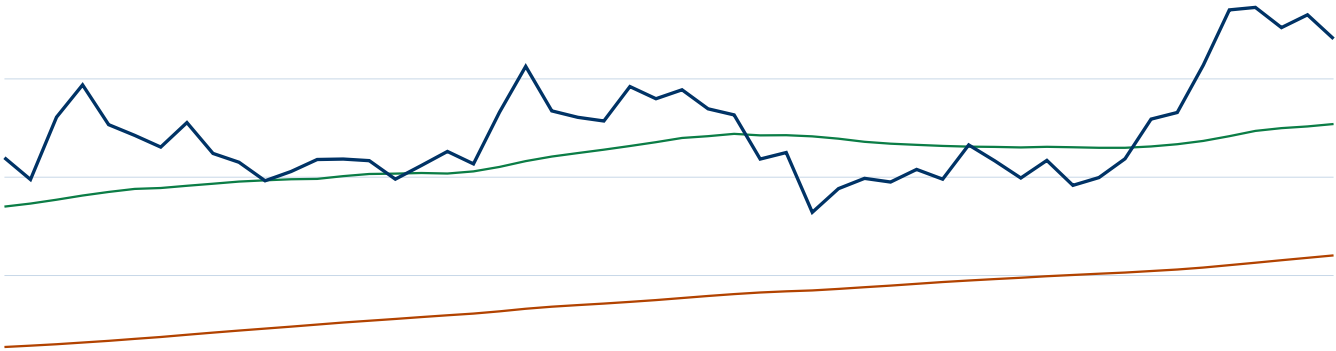

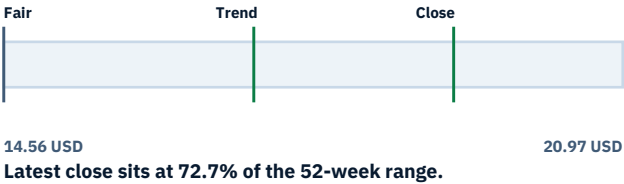

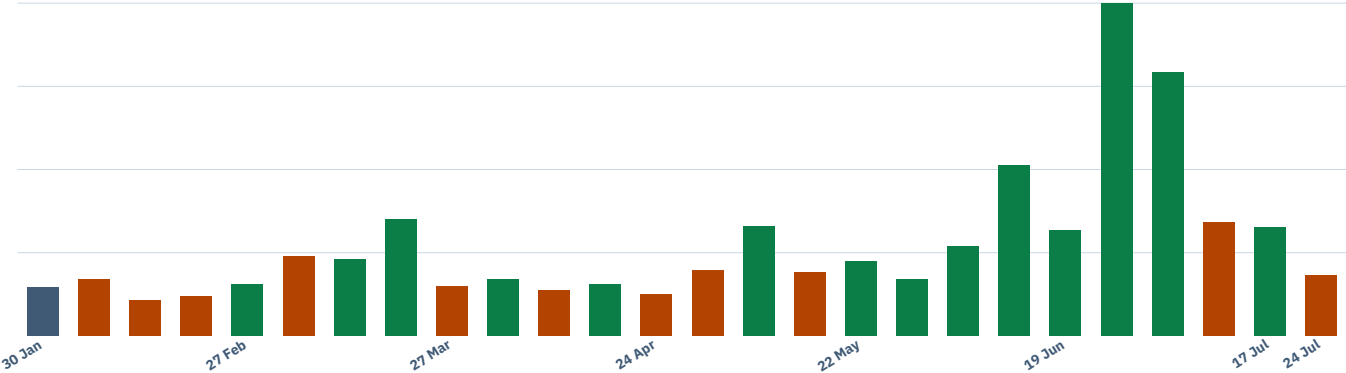
02 · VOLUME AND DEMAND

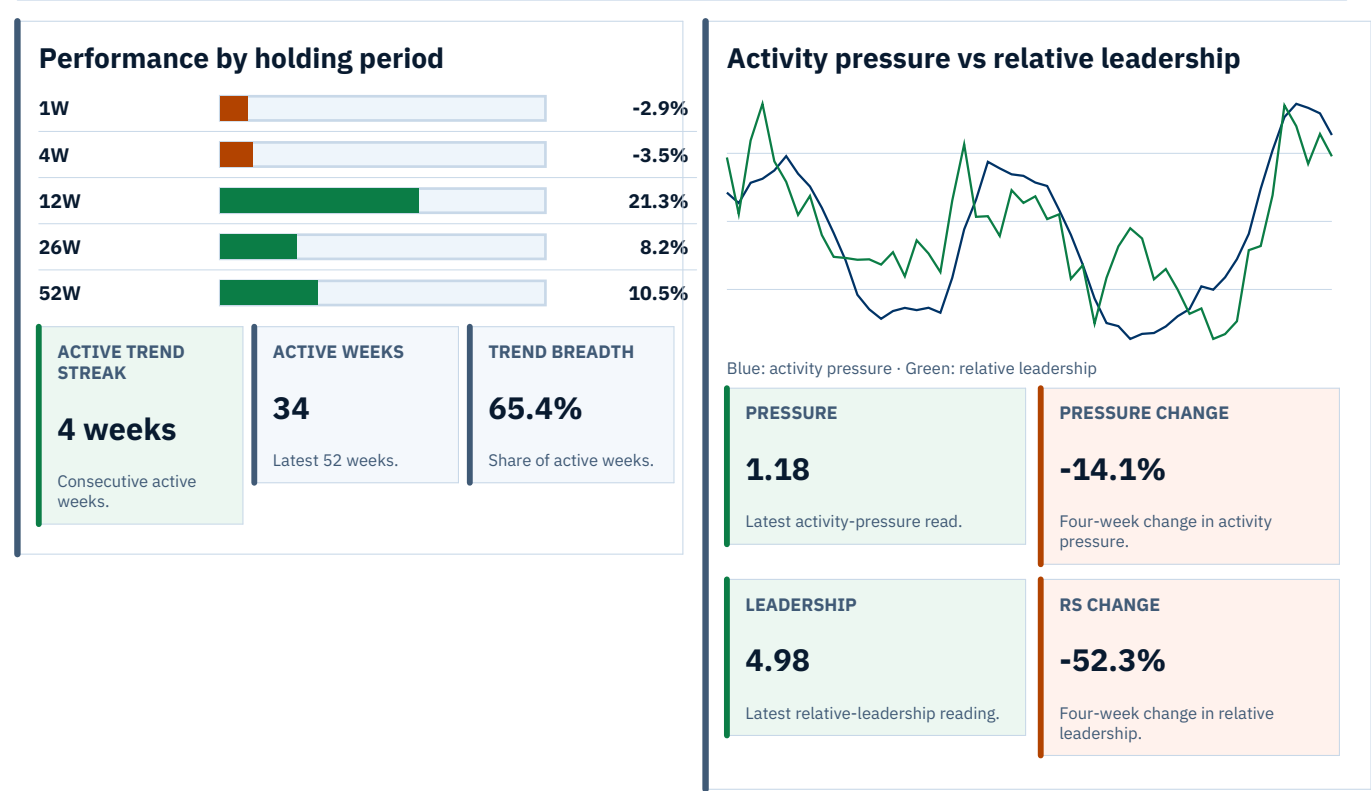

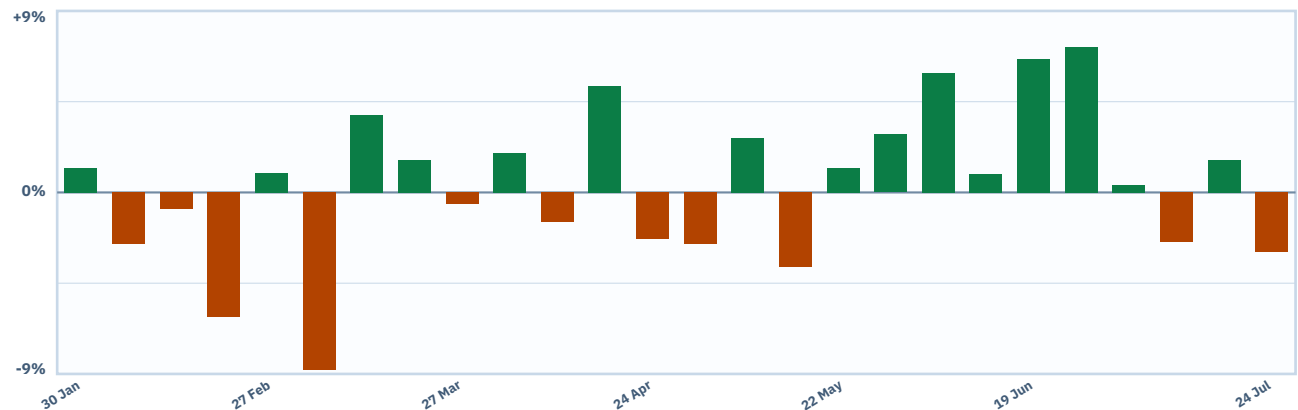
