Weekly setup

The weekly trend is active. Price is 37.7% above the Trend Line and sits at 83.2% of its 52-week range. The latest completed week returned -0.2%, after a 17.4% four-week move. The latest factor snapshot indicates quality ranks weakly versus its universe; growth ranks strongly; valuation is expensive relative to peers. Options positioning is volatility with 63/100 conviction, while the latest news-sentiment score is 56/100. Near-term considerations: earnings are due in 8d.

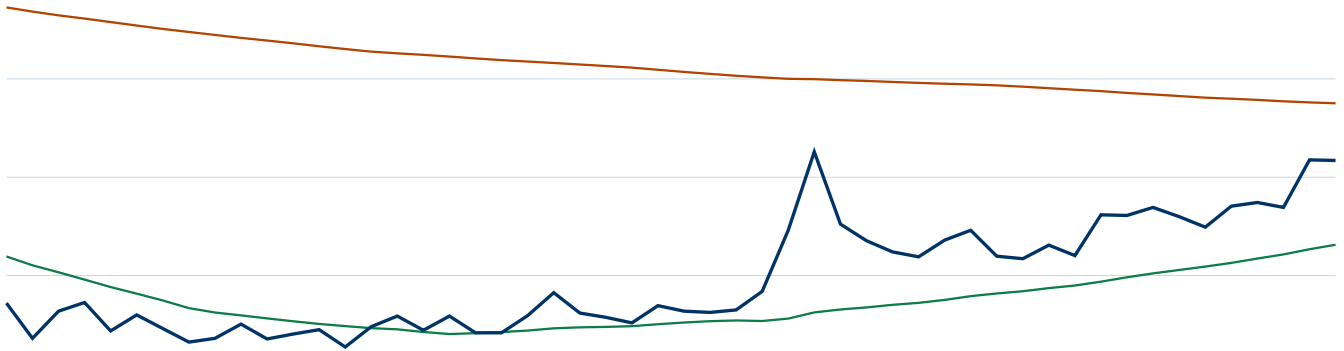

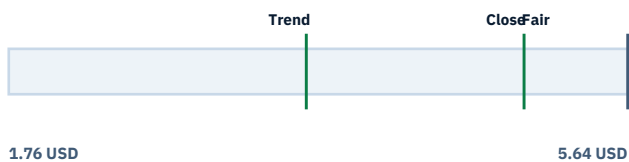

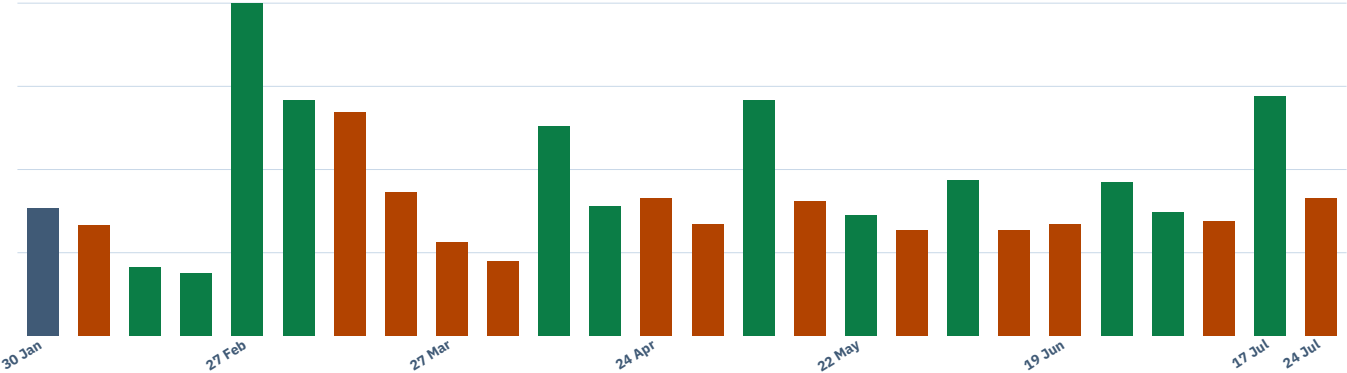

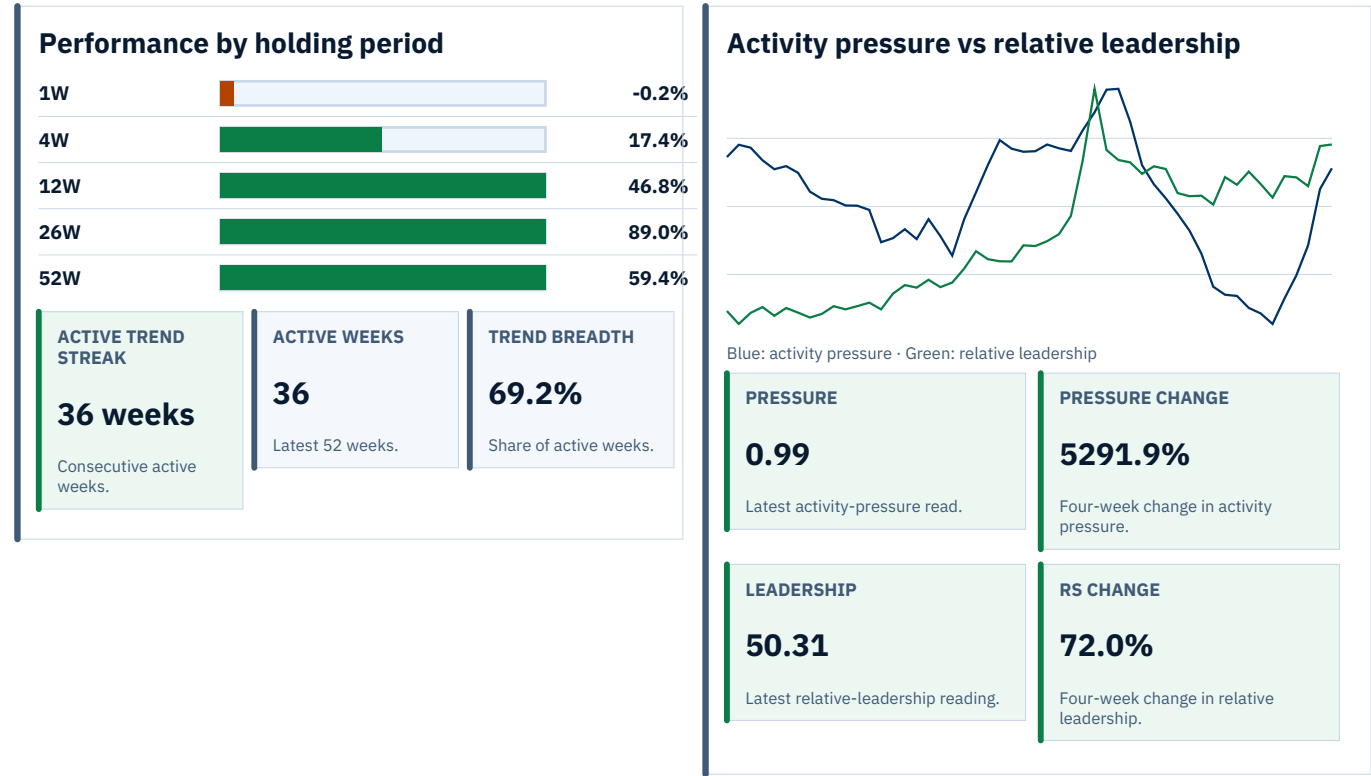

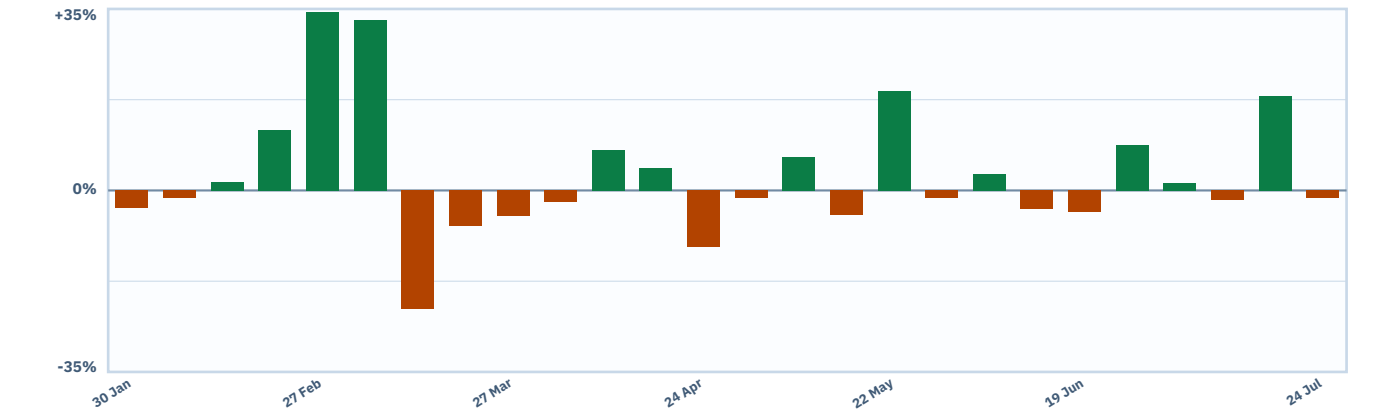
