Weekly setup

Constructive, but selective

The weekly trend is active. Price is 64.0% above the Trend Line and sits at 92.3% of its 52-week range. The latest completed week returned -1.1%, after a 25.3% four-week move. The latest factor snapshot indicates quality is middle-of-the-pack; growth is moderate; valuation is neither clearly cheap nor expensive. The latest news-sentiment score is 58/100. Near-term considerations: price is close to its 52-week high; earnings are due in 12d.

What to watch next

- Trend Line remains the key weekly regime level.

- A volume ratio above 1.5x would show stronger participation in the next move.

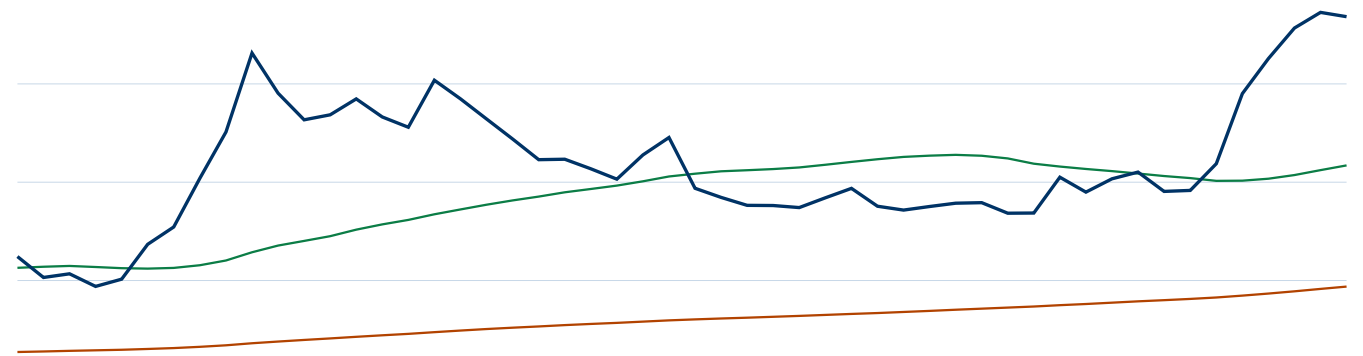

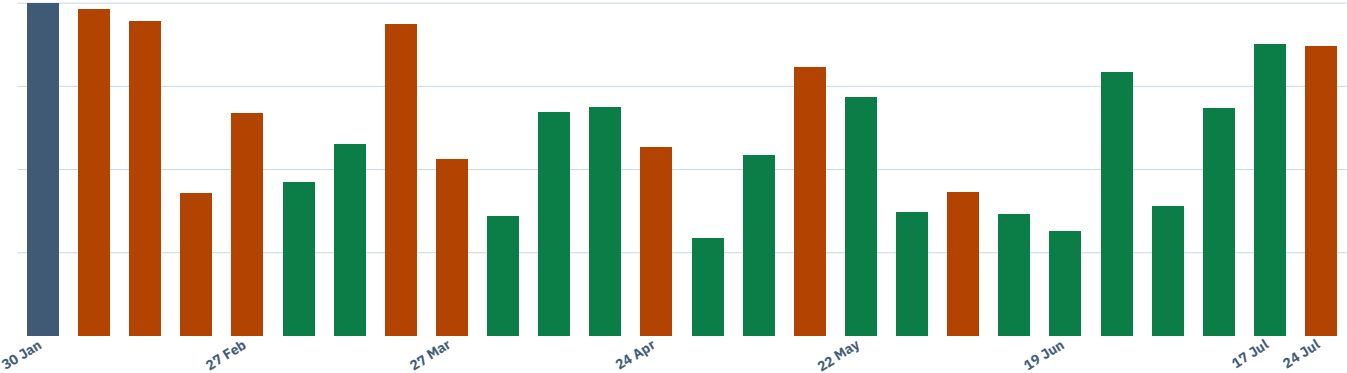
02 · VOLUME AND DEMAND

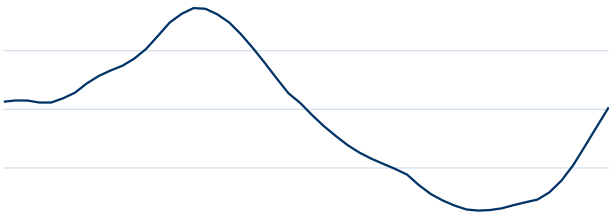

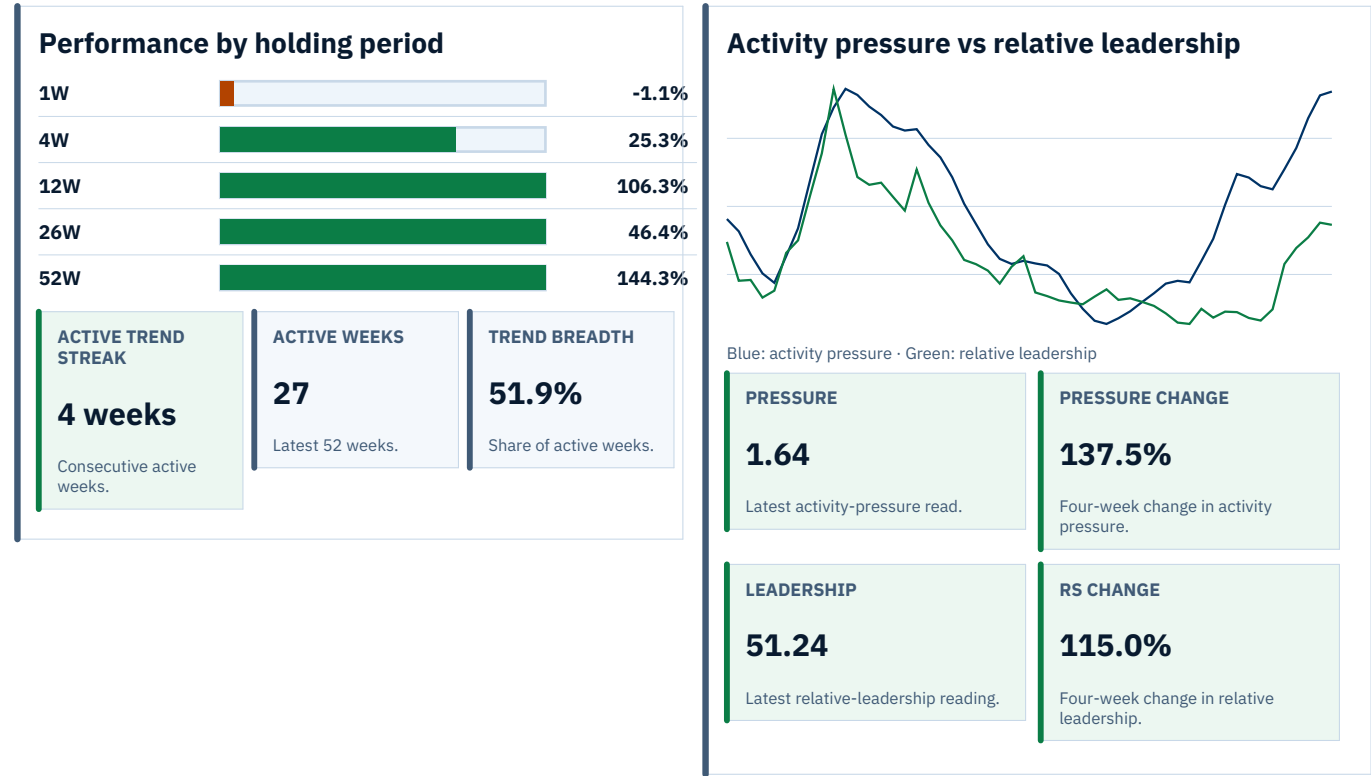

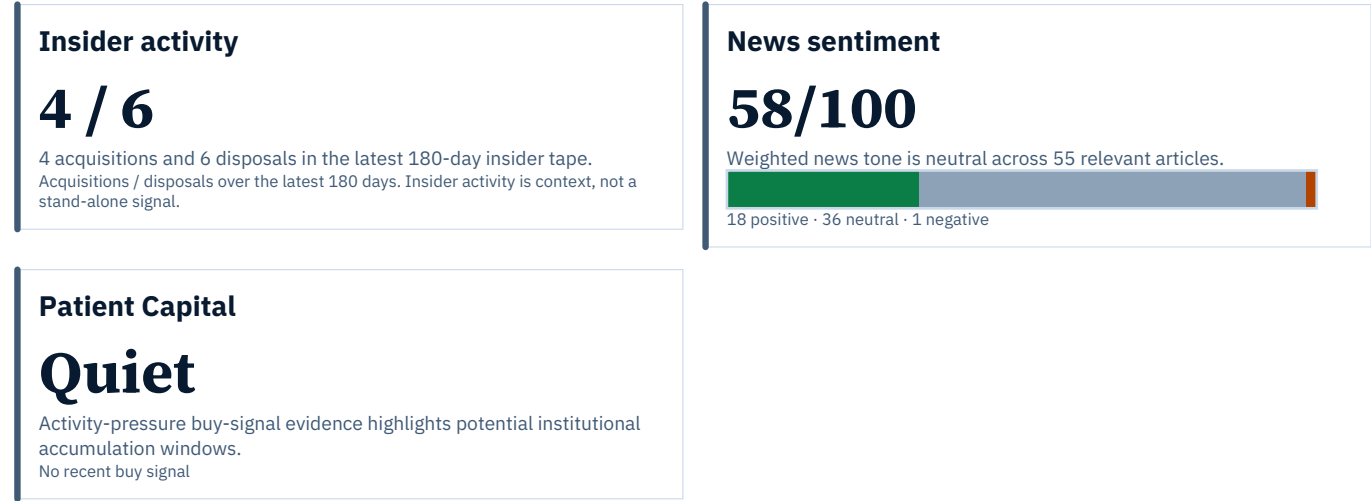

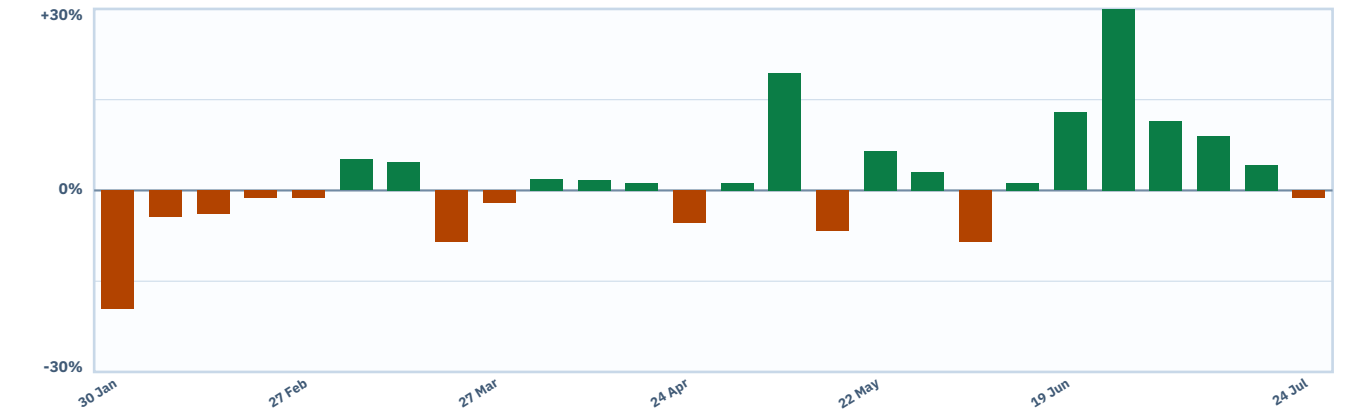
