The strongest supporting evidence is sentiment: Weighted news tone is neutral across 11 relevant articles. The main constraint is indicator analysis: Latest 12-week confirmation: trend 0/12, activity pressure 0/12, relative leadership 0/12. The combined read is defensive, so risk control and evidence of stabilization matter more than headline upside.

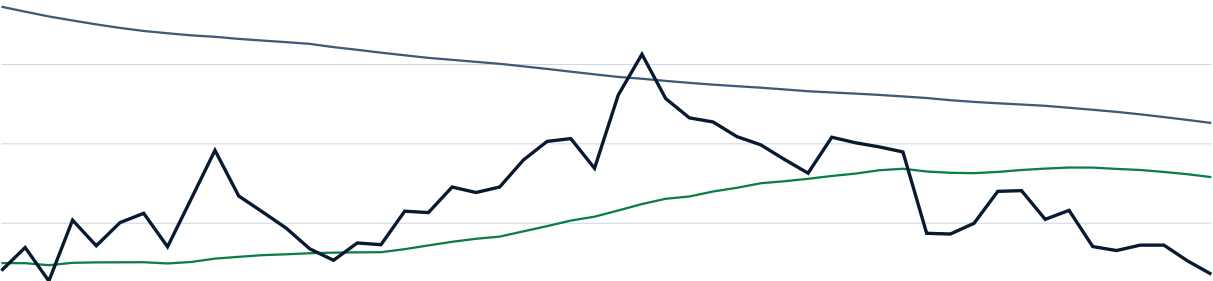

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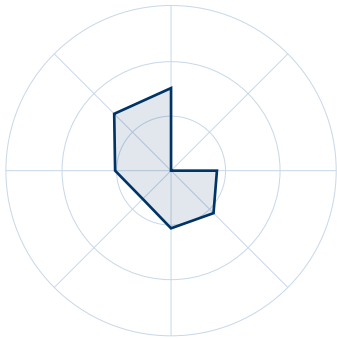

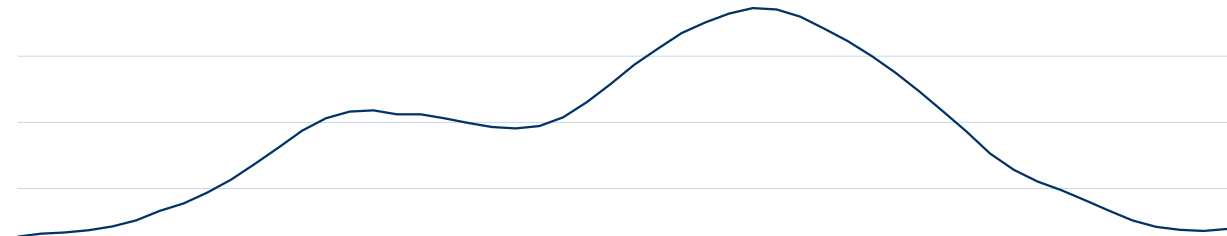

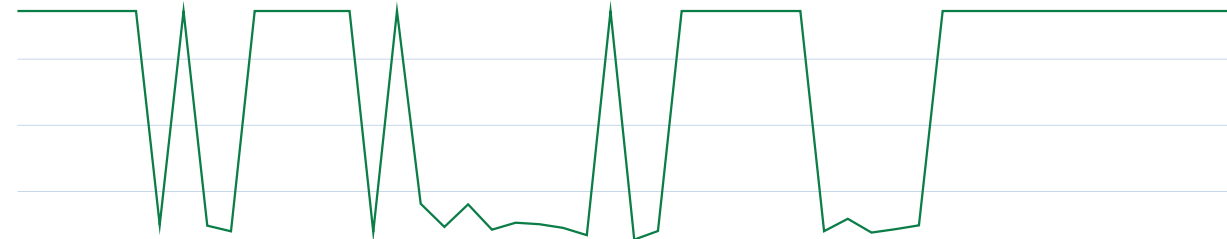

ACTIONABLE READ

Opportunities, risks, and watch points

Evidence clusters to monitor as the next weekly bar develops.

Opportunity signals

- No strong opportunity cluster is confirmed yet; monitor trend and activity pressure.

Risk signals

- The trend backdrop is inactive, so price action has not confirmed a constructive regime.
- Price is below the Trend Line, which keeps downside pressure in focus.
- Price is below Fair Value, so the market is still discounting the latest tape.
- Activity pressure is negative, which weakens the current setup.
- Activity pressure is weak, so confirmation is not yet broad enough.

Watch next

- Trend Line remains the key weekly regime level.
- Activity pressure is the gauge to monitor for confirmation or fade.
- A volume ratio above 1.5x would show stronger participation in the next move.
