Options positioning is bullish with 49/100 conviction, while the latest news-sentiment score is 58/100. Near-term considerations: price is close to its 52-week high; earnings are due in 0d.

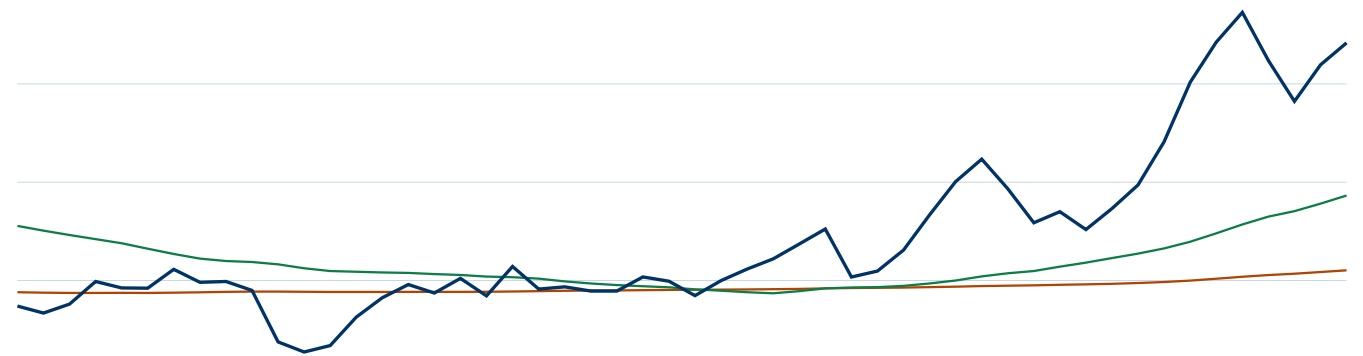

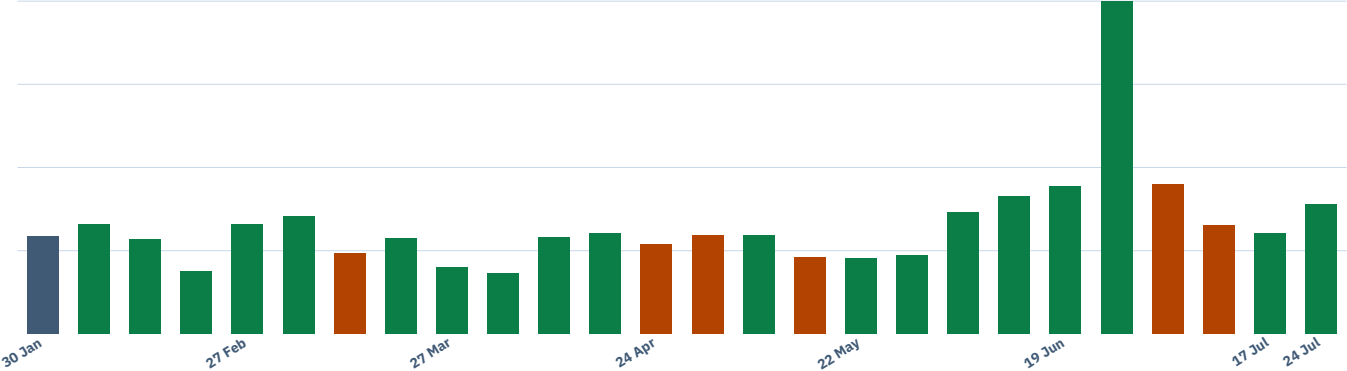
02 · VOLUME AND DEMAND

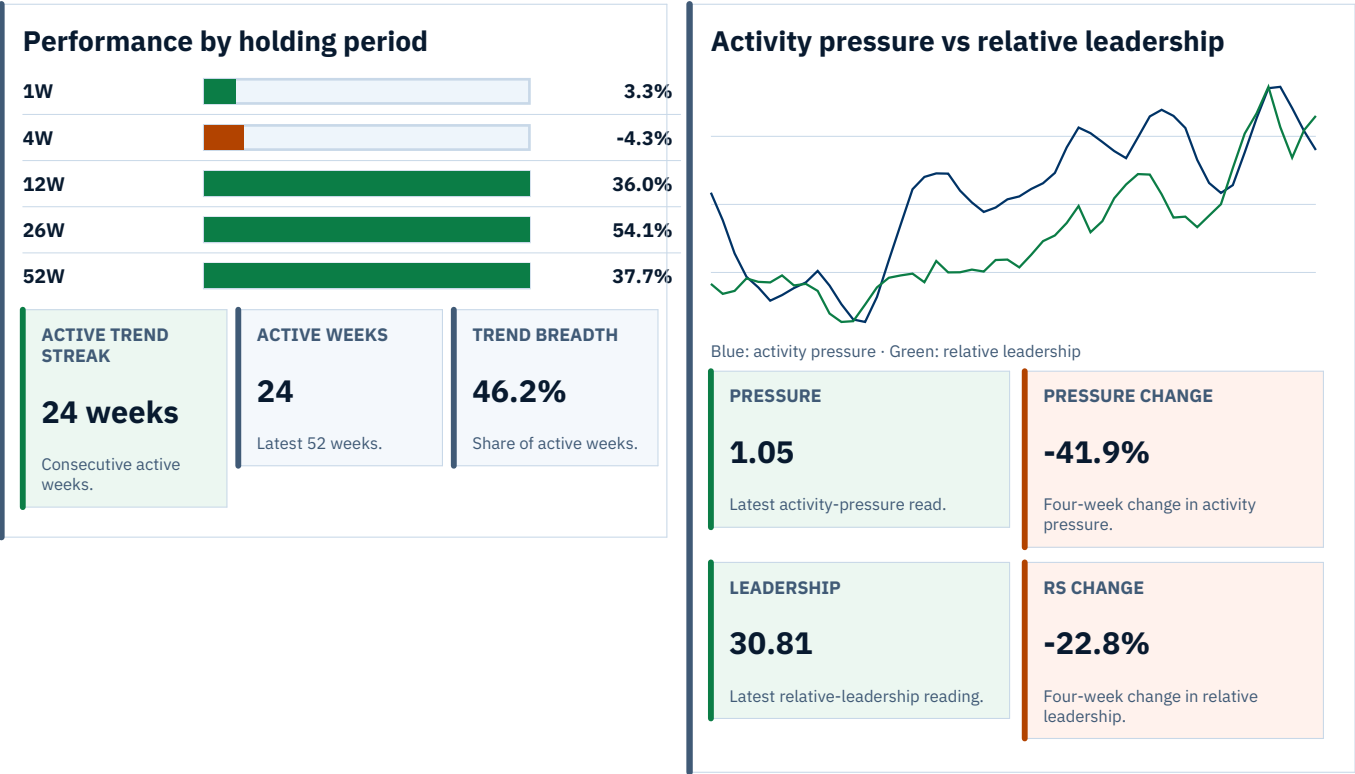

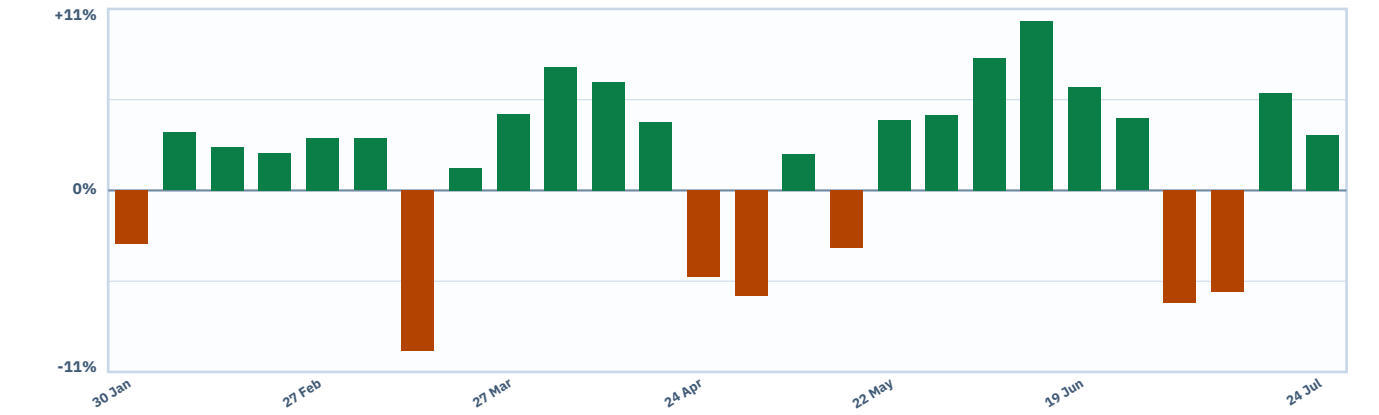
