The weekly trend is not active. Price is 3.3% above the Trend Line and sits at 78.5% of its 52-week range. The latest completed week returned 2.0%, after a 9.9% four-week move. The latest factor snapshot indicates quality ranks weakly versus its universe; growth is moderate; valuation is neither clearly cheap nor expensive. Options positioning is mixed with 34/100 conviction, while the latest news-sentiment score is 55/100. Near-term considerations: volume confirmation is below normal.

Technical setup score 54/100. This score describes the weekly technical setup; the conclusion above also considers fundamentals, positioning, sentiment, and event risk.

What is working

- Price is above the Trend Line, keeping the weekly tape constructive.

- The trend backdrop is inactive, so price action has not confirmed a constructive regime.
- Activity pressure is negative, which weakens the current setup.
- 12 reversal markers appear in the recent smart-money tape.

What to watch next

- Trend Line remains the key weekly regime level.
- Activity pressure is the gauge to monitor for confirmation or fade.
- A volume ratio above 1.5x would show stronger participation in the next move.

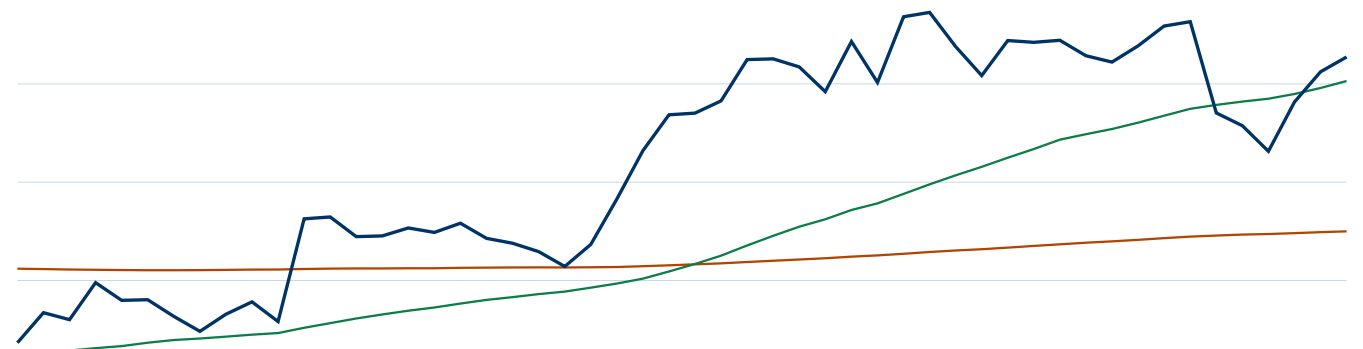

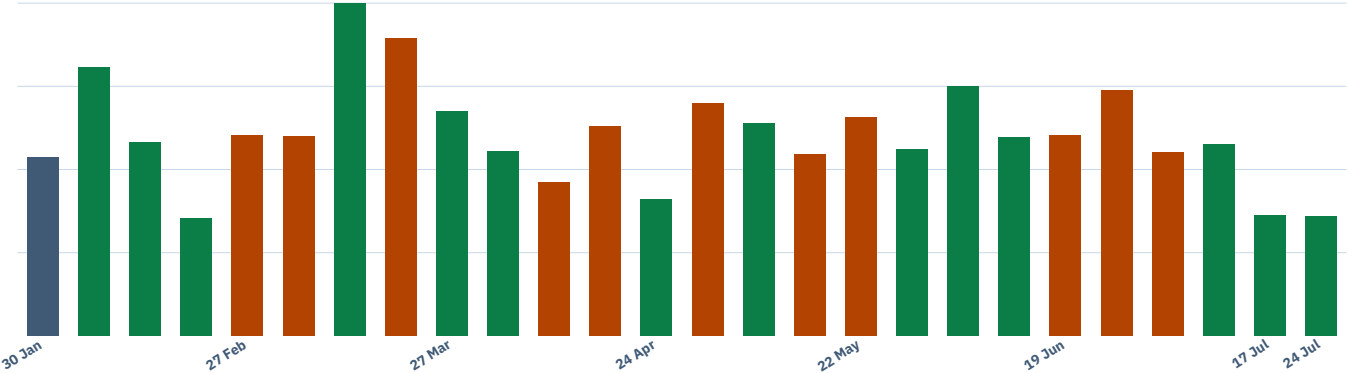
02 · VOLUME AND DEMAND

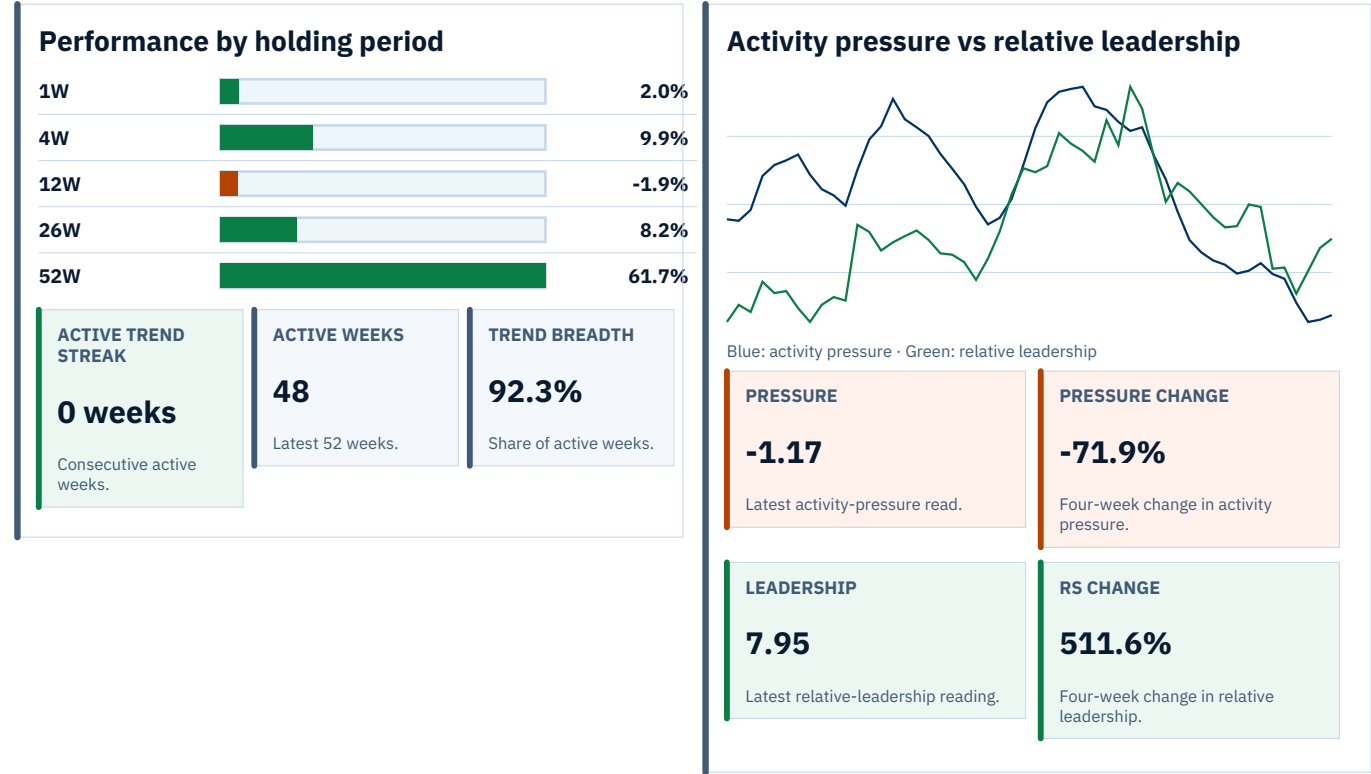

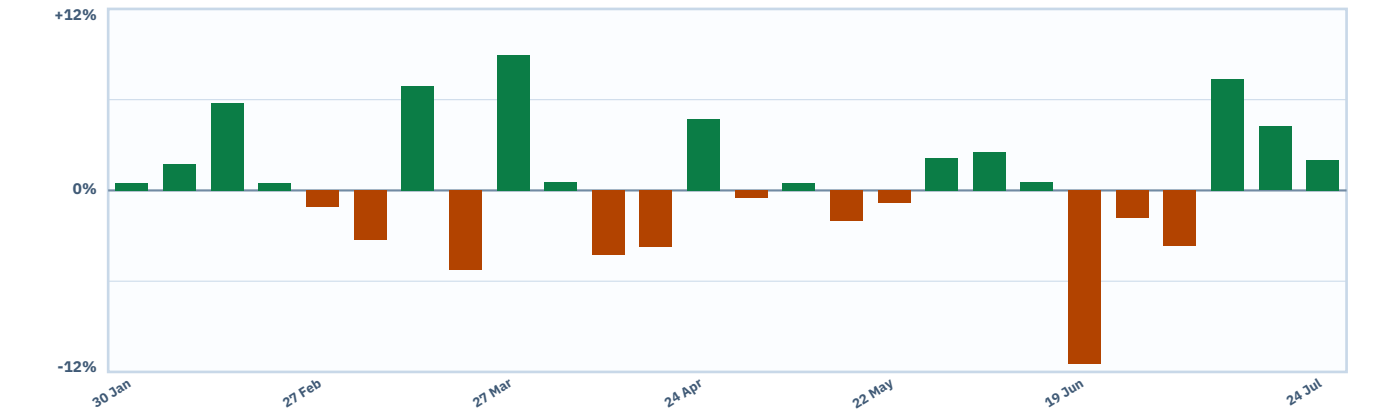
