Weekly setup

Constructive, but selective

The weekly trend is active. Price is 60.8% above the Trend Line and sits at 85.9% of its 52-week range. The latest completed week returned -1.9%, after a 41.8% four-week move. The latest factor snapshot indicates quality ranks weakly versus its universe; growth is moderate; valuation is neither clearly cheap nor expensive. Options positioning is bearish with 38/100 conviction, while the latest news-sentiment score is 63/100. Near-term considerations: earnings are due in 78d.

Technical setup score 62/100. This score describes the weekly technical setup; the conclusion above also considers fundamentals, positioning, sentiment, and event risk.

- No major top-level risk cluster is currently dominant.

What to watch next

- Trend Line remains the key weekly regime level.
- Activity pressure is the gauge to monitor for confirmation or fade.
- A volume ratio above 1.5x would show stronger participation in the next move.

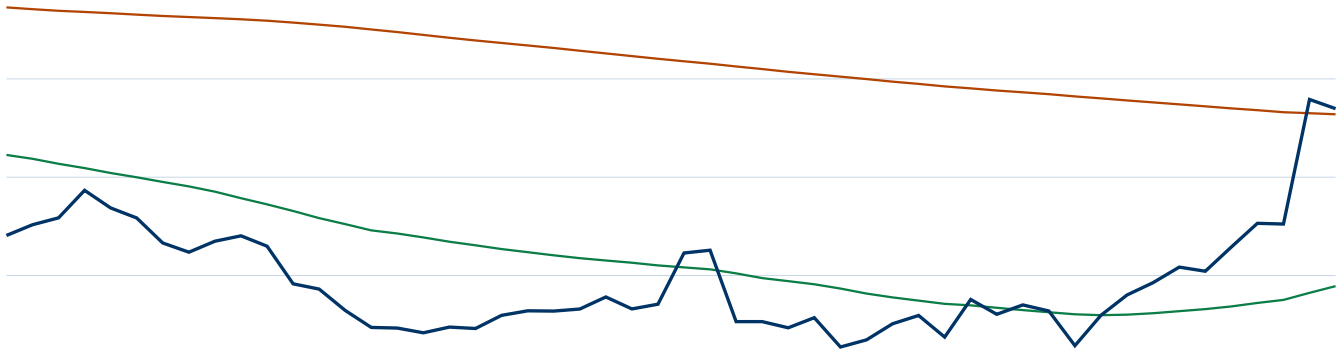

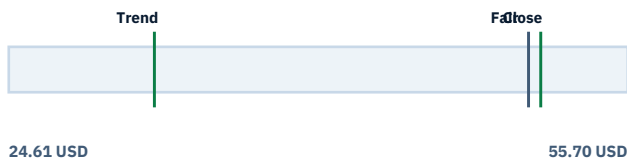

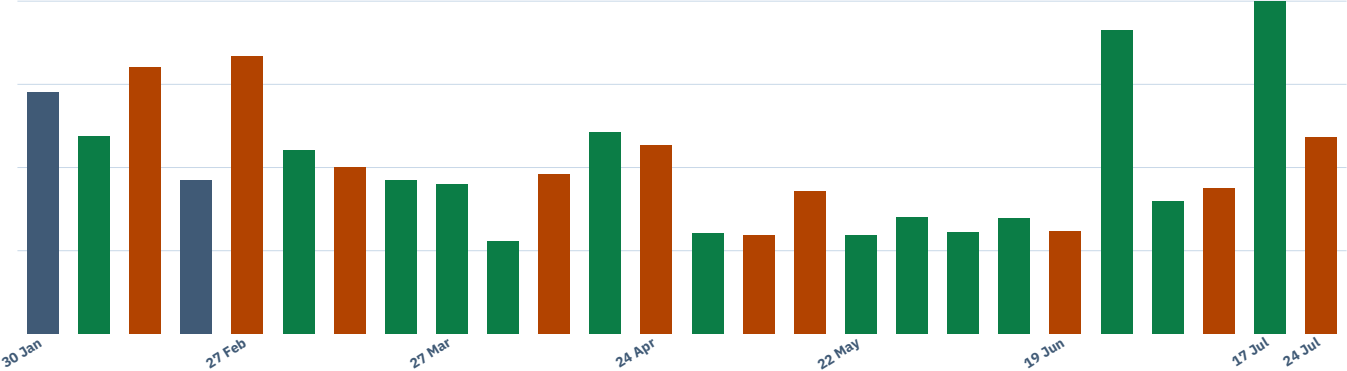
02 · VOLUME AND DEMAND

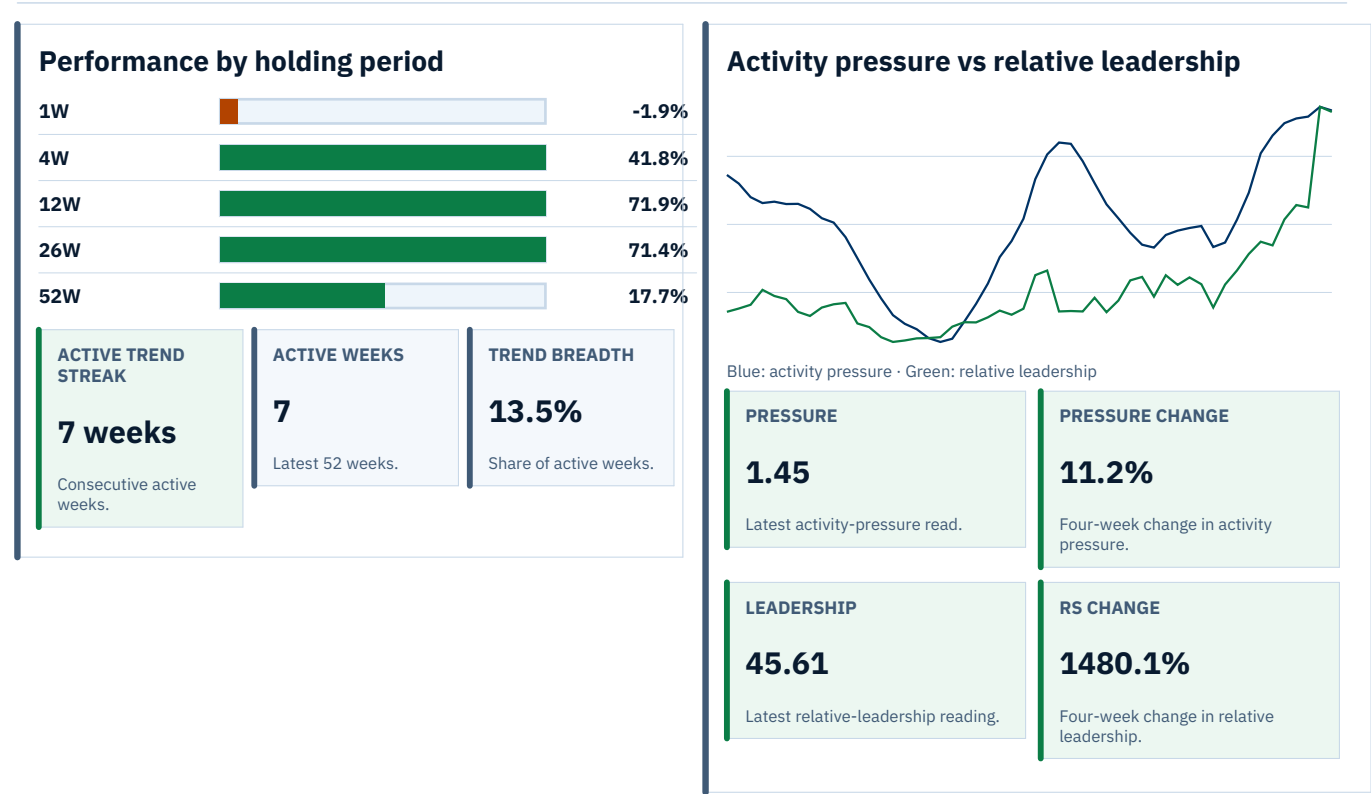

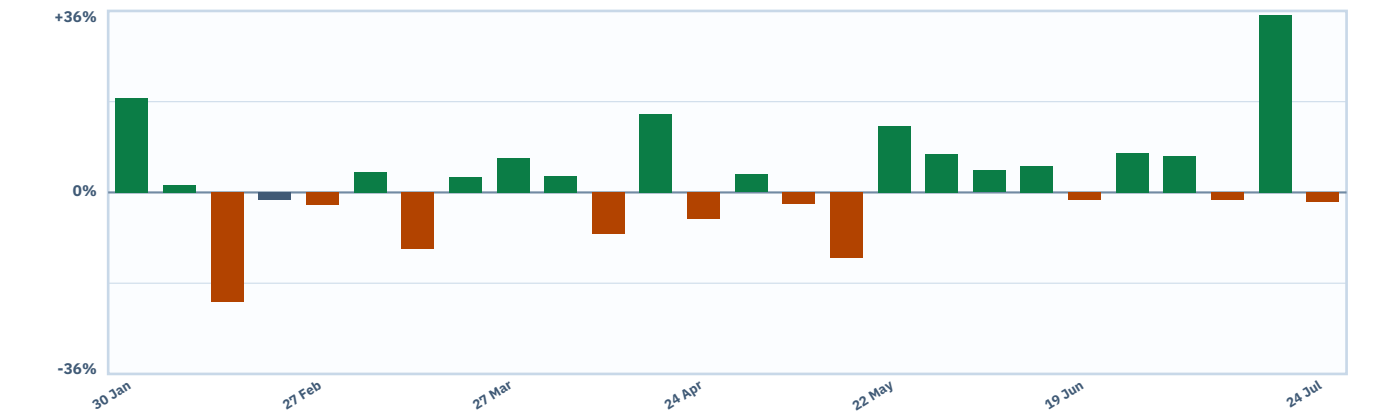
