Weekly setup

Constructive, but selective

The weekly trend is active. Price is 17.8% above the Trend Line and sits at 73.5% of its 52-week range. The latest completed week returned -1.1%, after a 1.7% four-week move. The latest factor snapshot indicates quality is middle-of-the-pack; growth ranks weakly; valuation is neither clearly cheap nor expensive. Options positioning is mixed with 31/100 conviction, while the latest news-sentiment score is 59/100. Near-term considerations: earnings are due in 7d.

Technical setup score 61/100. This score describes the weekly technical setup; the conclusion above also considers fundamentals, positioning, sentiment, and event risk.

- The trend backdrop is active with a 11-week active streak.

- Activity pressure is positive on the latest completed week.

What could go wrong

- Next-week expectancy is negative at 44.32% based on similar historical setup states.
- 1 reversal markers appear in the recent smart-money tape.

What to watch next

- Trend Line remains the key weekly regime level.
- Activity pressure is the gauge to monitor for confirmation or fade.
- A volume ratio above 1.5x would show stronger participation in the next move.

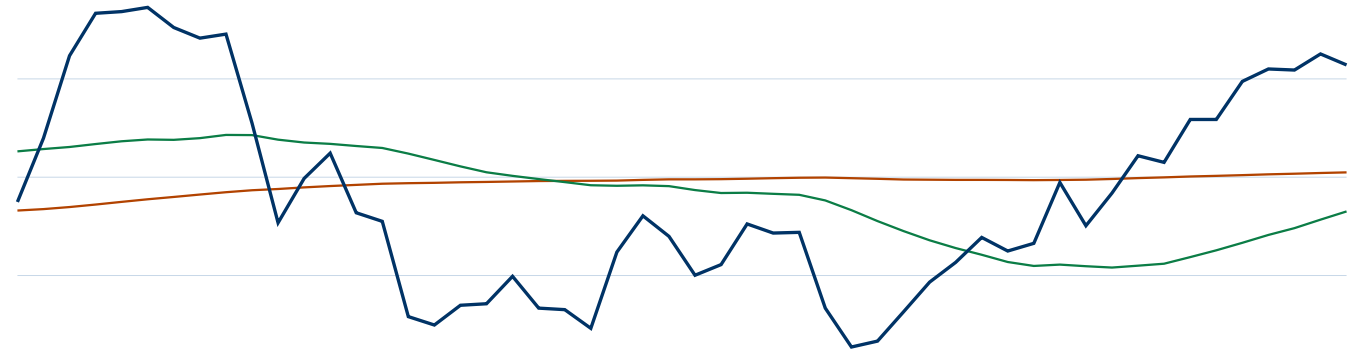

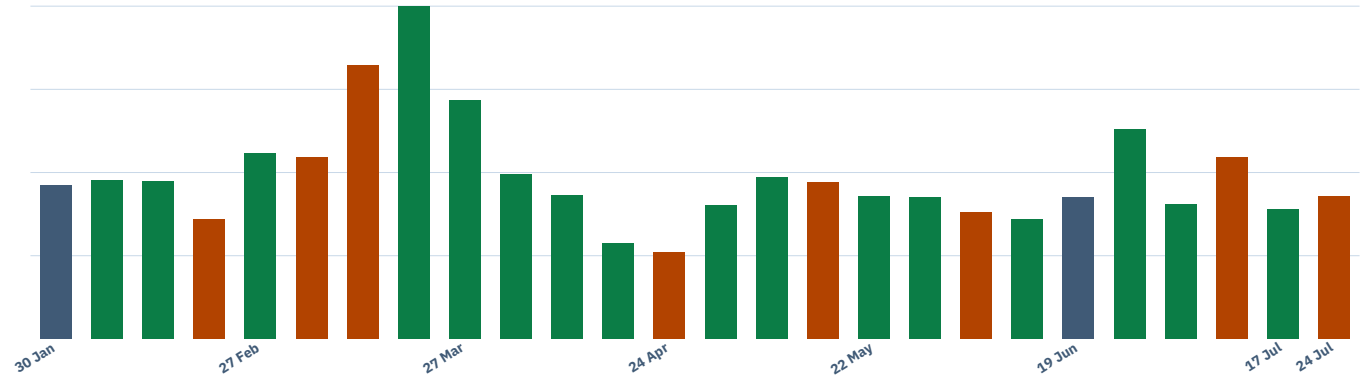
02 · VOLUME AND DEMAND

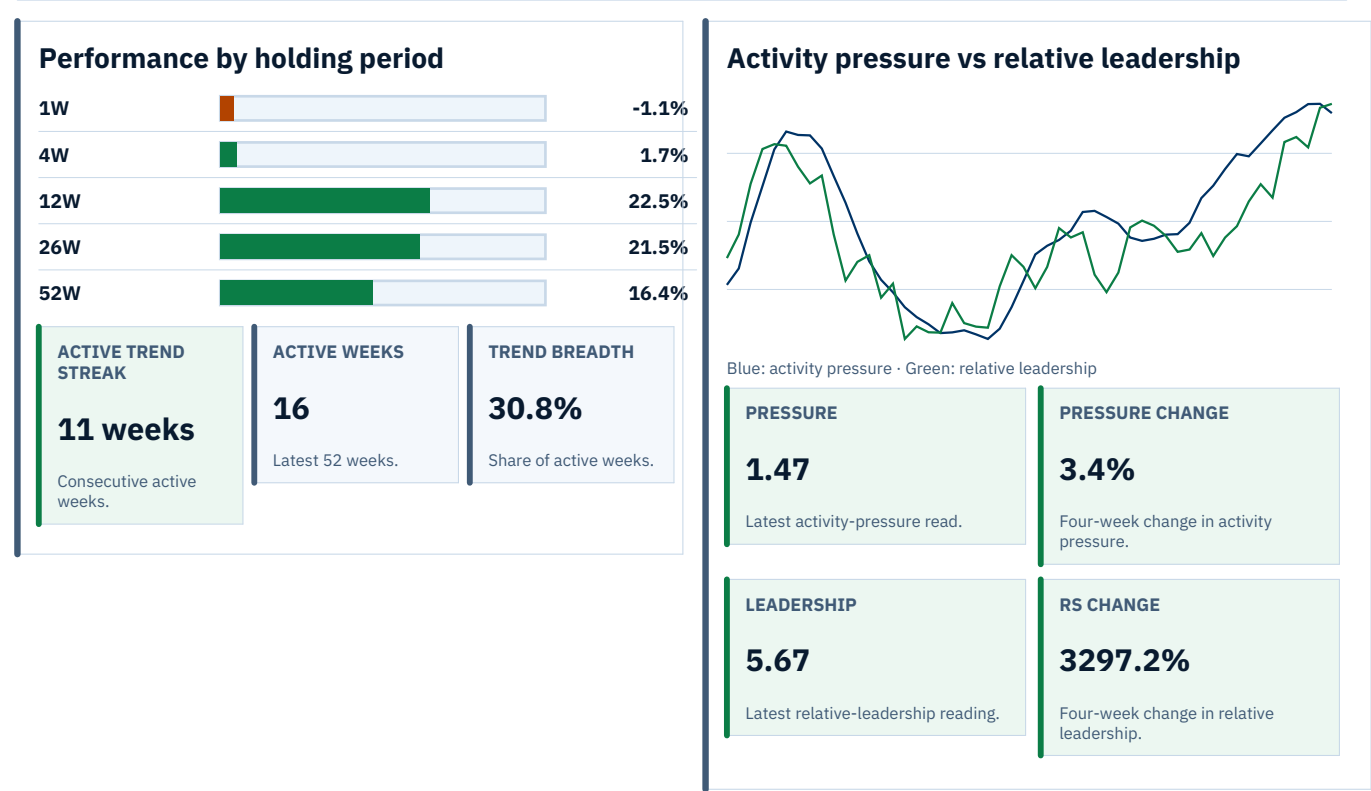

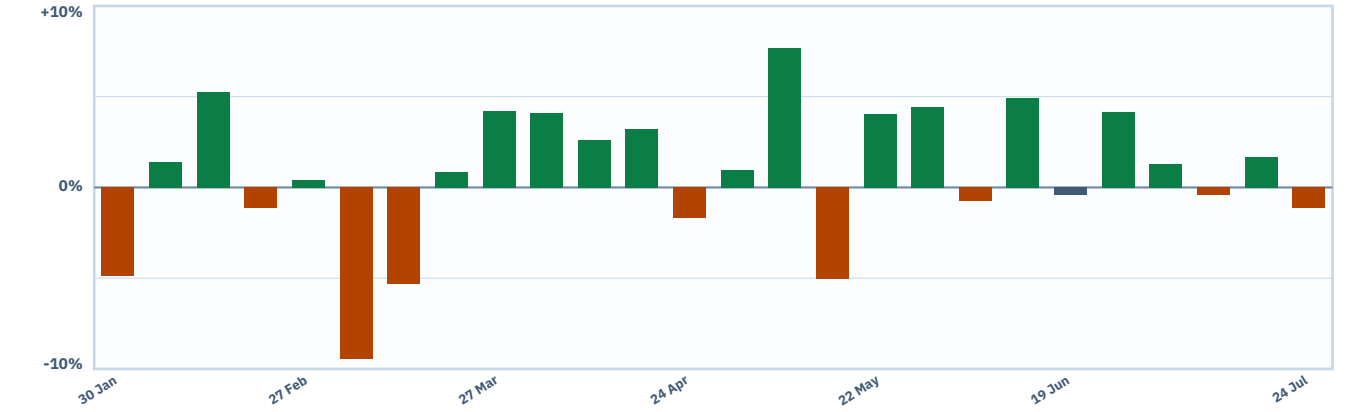
