The main constraint is svqf: Value and quality alignment from the Sharemaestro SVQF framework. The combined read is defensive, so risk control and evidence of stabilization matter more than headline upside.

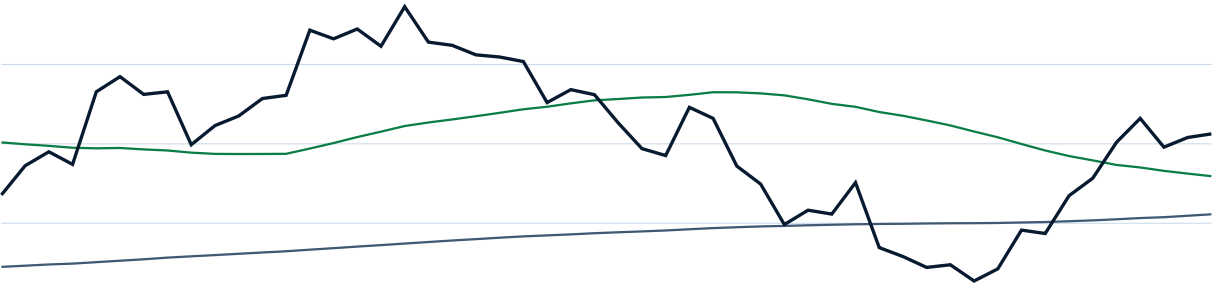

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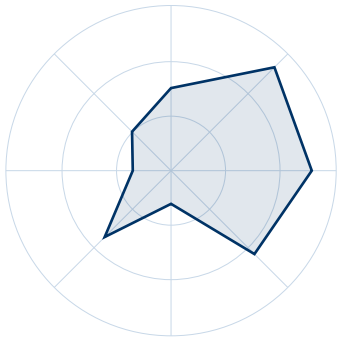

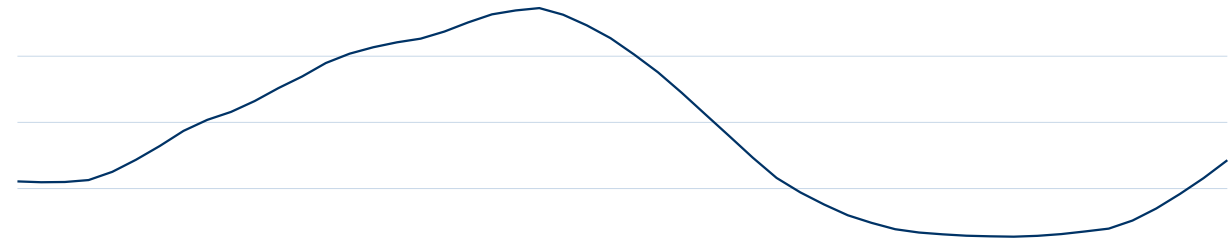

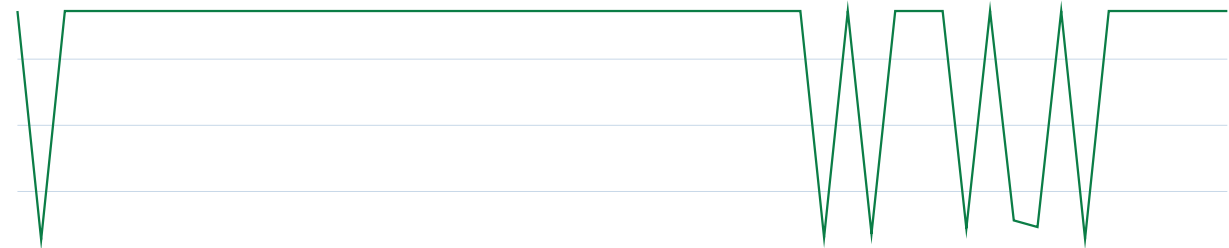

Opportunities, risks, and watch points

Opportunity signals

- Price is above the Trend Line, keeping the weekly tape constructive.
- Price is above Fair Value, showing premium demand versus the model.
- Activity pressure is positive on the latest completed week.

Risk signals

- The trend backdrop is inactive, so price action has not confirmed a constructive regime.
- Activity pressure is weak, so confirmation is not yet broad enough.

Watch next

- Trend Line remains the key weekly regime level.
- Activity pressure is the gauge to monitor for confirmation or fade.
- A volume ratio above 1.5x would show stronger participation in the next move.
